| 1 Magisterium | The teaching authority of the Catholic Church, made up of the Pope and bishops. | |
| 2 Old Testament | The first part of the Bible that tells Christians about God's relationship with the Jewish people before Jesus was born. | |
| 3 New Testament | The second part of the Bible that tells Christians about Jesus' life on earth and the early Christian Church. | |
| PRAYER | | |
| 4 Theist | A person who believes in God. | |
| 5 Adoration | A type of prayer that praises God. | |
| 6 Contrition | A type of prayer that says sorry to God for any wrongdoing. | |
| 7 Thanksgiving | A type of prayer that says thank you to God. | |
| 8 Supplication | A type of prayer that asks God for things. | |
| THE SACRAMENTS | | |
| 9 Sacraments | A visible sign of God's invisible grace. | |
| 10 Sacraments of Initiation | The three sacraments that make a person a full member of the Catholic Church: baptism, Holy Communion and confirmation. | |
| LENT AND EASTER | | |
| 11 Holy Week | The last week of Jesus' life. | |
| 12 Palm Sunday | The first day of Holy Week when Jesus entered Jerusalem on a donkey. | |
| 13 Maundy Thursday | The Thursday of Holy Week when Jesus ate his last supper with the disciples and instituted (started) the Eucharist (Holy Communion). | |
| 14 Good Friday | The last day of Holy Week when Jesus was crucified and died on the cross. | |
| 15. Ascension | 40 days after the resurrection, Jesus ascended (went up) to heaven to be seated at the right hand of the Father. | |

| 16. Annunciation | When the angel <i>Gabriel</i> visited Mary to tell her she would be the mother of <i>God</i> and that she was to call him <i>Jesus</i> . | |

| 18 Vocation | A calling from <i>God</i> to a particular job or way of life. | |

| 20 Grace | <i>God's</i> love. | |
| 21 Sanctity of Life principle | The belief that life is holy and belongs to <i>God</i> . | |
| 22. Omnibenevolent | <i>God</i> is all-loving. | |
| 23 Omnipotent | <i>God</i> is all-powerful. | |
| 24 Omniscient | <i>God</i> is all-knowing | |
| 25 Transcendent | <i>God</i> is beyond time and space. | |
