Activity to undertake:

- 4 separate activities related to utopian and dystopian literature on Word document.

<u>Task 1</u>: Read extract from Kids Britannica and answer questions about the origins of utopian literature.

<u>Task 2</u>: Read extract from Tom's Midnight Garden by Philippa Pearce and find 3 quotations to show the garden is utopian.

<u>Task 3</u>: Read extract from the opening of 1984 by George Orwell and list 5 dystopian features of the world described.

<u>Task 4</u>: Learn the key words and their definitions for a test in September. Words are organised into "Concept" words related to the themes and ideas in the novel; and "Literary / English" words to support analysis of genre and the writer's techniques.
