# Councillor Job Description



- **Be a good listener** – you need to listen to the concerns and ideas of your fellow students.
- **Be a good communicator** – you will need to speak to members of the Senior Leadership team and other key adults during meetings. You will also have to feed back to your form following meetings.
- **Be organised** – meetings happen 4 times a year, you need to make sure you know what will be discussed at the meeting and have asked your fellow students for their ideas **before** the meeting.
- **Be friendly** – the more students you chat to about the meeting themes, the better you will be able to represent them.
