# Year 11 Literature Mock Exam – March 2022:

## Literature Component 1 - 2 hours:

## Section A - The Merchant of Venice extract and essay MoV:

The extract could be from anywhere in the play. You will need to revise using your annotated MoV extract booklets issued in Year 10 and the responses written in your MoV exercise book.

The essay will be either a character, relationship between characters or a theme.

## **Section A Exam Timing:**

Extract: 15 marks - 20 mins

Essay: 25 marks - 40 mins

## Section B An Inspector Calls:

One extract-based essay question worth 40 marks and you should spend 1 hour on this question. Your question will be on a character, relationship between characters or a theme.

## Literature Component 2 - 2 hours

#### Section A - A Christmas Carol - 1 hour:

One extract-based essay question worth 40 marks.

Your question will focus on character, relationship between characters or a theme.

You must refer to context.

#### **Section B Unseen Poetry**

Unseen poetry will consist of two questions.

One single poem question and one comparative poetry question.

You will be expected to compare two poems about a similar theme.

You should revise using your unseen poetry booklets issued in Year 10 and any other revision material issued by your class teacher.

#### **C2** Section B Exam Timing:

Single poem: 15 marks - 20 mins

Compare poems: 25 marks - 40 mins
