SOME ADDITIONAL SUGGESTIONS THAT YOU MAY WISH TO DO TO HELP YOU TO PREPARE FOR SEPTEMBER

- Our college astro turf is **NOT A 3G surface** therefore all football lessons and training sessions have a zero policy on studded football boots as they damage the surface. Students must wear trainers/astro turf trainers only.
- It is preferable that boys have their own football boots for rugby lessons and if they wish to attend after school rugby/football training sessions. However, if your child does not own any football boots, we have a selection of boots they are welcome to lend from our spare kit box.
- If your child is ill/injured they must provide a note from their parent/carer or Doctor of why they cannot take part. We still expect them to bring their PE kit as they are still expected to be an important part of the lesson as a coach, umpire, referee, volunteer etc. Also if it rains or is muddy and we are outside, their uniform will not become wet/dirty if they are wearing their PE kit.
