

Year 7 Assessment

All students in Year 7 will be sitting the same assessment. This will be a non-calculator assessment which will be out of 50. The papers will contain a mixture of A01 (recall of facts), A02 (interpreting and communicating) and A03 (problem solving). The maximum mark for any question will be 3 marks. The topics that will appear are:

Rounding Numbers	Fraction arithmetic
Perimeter and area	Finding a fraction of a quantity
Naming triangles and quadrilaterals	Simple non-calculator percentage
Symmetry	Averages (mode, median, mean and range)
Basic angle facts (angles in a triangle, quadrilateral, on a straight line)	Conversion of units (g to kg , ml to l, cm to m)
Factors and Multiples	Sequences
Representing Data (pie charts and bar charts)
