






During the Liturgy of the Word we listen to readings from the bible.

The people who wrote these readings were inspired by the Holy Spirit to do so.


Therefore the Bible is <u>The Word of God</u> and this helps us to know how God wants us to live.


This then is what I pray, kneeling before the Father:

Then, planted in love, and built on love, with all God's holy people, you will have the strength to grasp the breadth and the length, the height, and the depth of God's love.





And leaving the crowd behind, they took him, just as he was, in the boat; and there were other boats with him.






Then it began to blow a gale and the waves were breaking into the boat so that it was almost swamped.







THE OFFERTORY


The gifts of <u>bread</u> and <u>wine</u> are brought to the altar.

When he does this he uses the <u>same words</u> as Jesus said during the Last Supper.





We will now <u>share communion together</u> by either receiving the Body of Jesus or a blessing.


This is a most special time within the Mass and should be treated with <u>great reverence</u>.

Father and Mr. McCormack will now outline how we should respond during communion.


