


During the Liturgy of the Word we listen to readings from the bible.

COMMUNICON




We will now <u>share communion together</u> by either receiving the Body of Jesus or a blessing.

This is a most special time within the Mass and should be treated with great reverence.


Mr. McCormack will now outline the arrangements and how we should respond during communion.


