The people who wrote these readings were inspired by the Holy Spirit to do so.

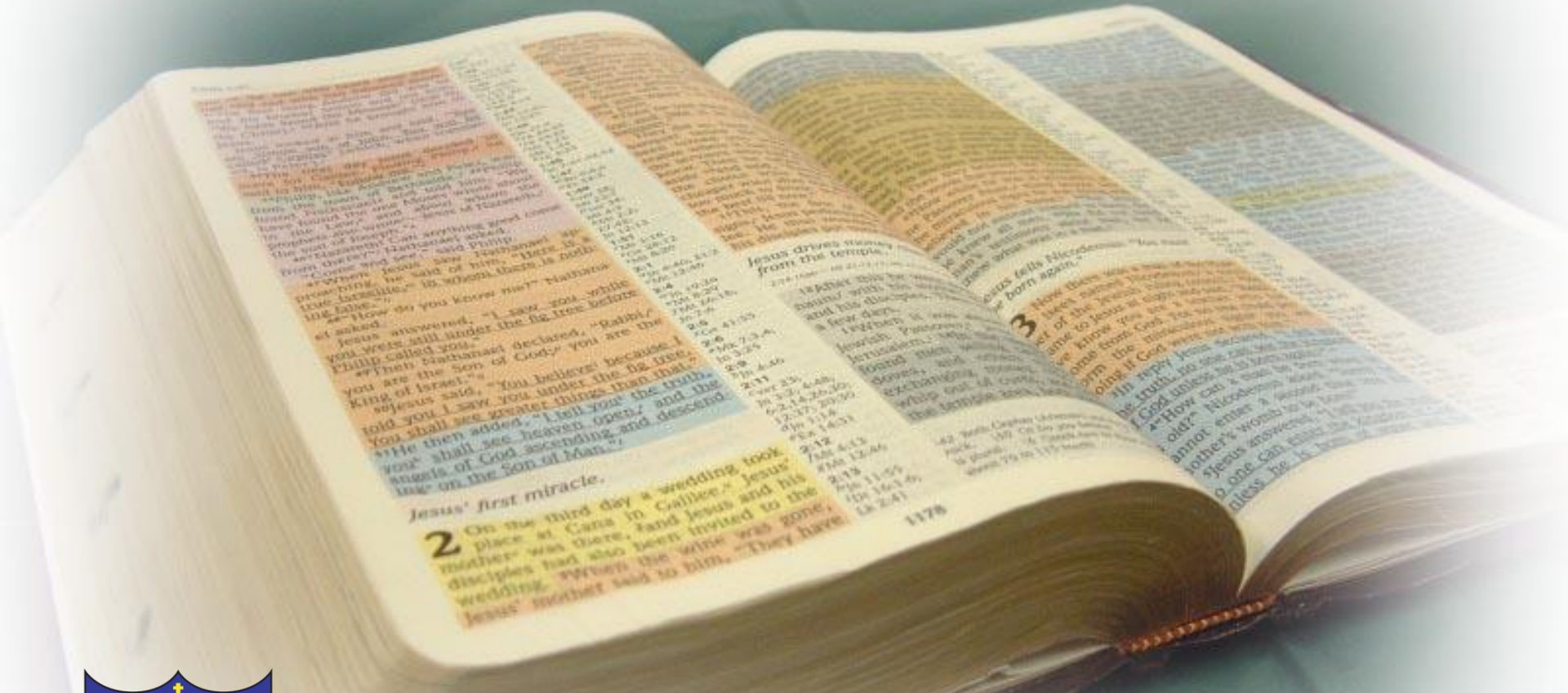

# THE MARTYRS SHRINE AT THE TOP OF REDHILL

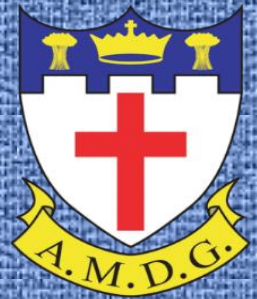

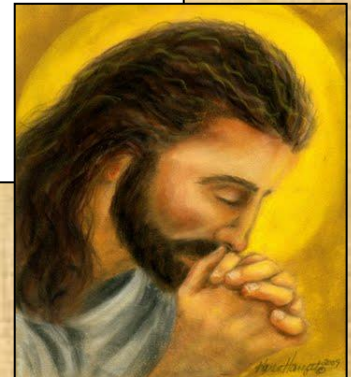


## PLEASE STAND

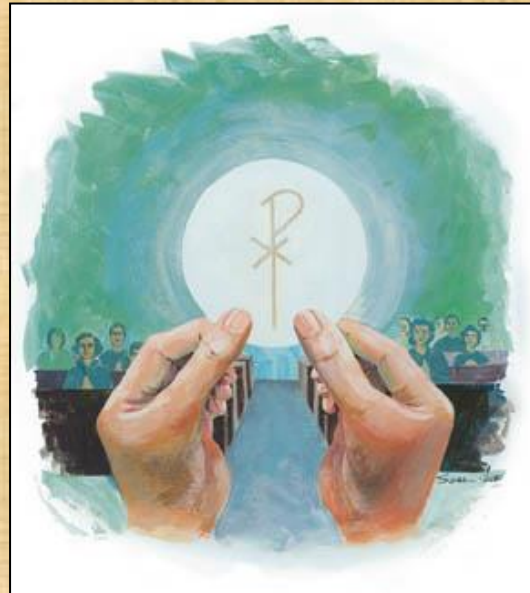

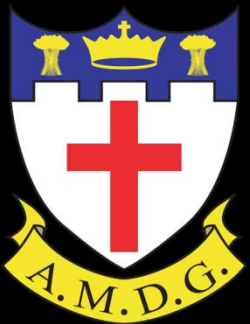


We will now share communion together by either receiving the Body of Jesus or a blessing.
