IN MEMORY OF BLESSED JOHN WALL O.S.F. AND

FOR TWELVE YEARS BLESSED JOHN WALL DEBARRED  
HE PRIESTLY OFFICE BY FERRINGTON HALL,  
CHURCHLEY, COBURN AND IN OTHER PARTS OF  
THIS COUNTY IN DAILY PERIL OF DEATH.  
JOHN WALL WAS ORIGINALLY BORN IN 1545  
AND WAS HANGED NEAR THE BAY ON THE  
BANKS OF THE RUMMERON ABOUT 22<sup>ND</sup> 1673  
FRANCIS GLOUCESTER MURDER  
EQUESTRIS CAUSIS  
THIS MEMORIAL WAS ERECTED BY THE REV. FATHER  
JOHN DE JONGE N.S.M. WORCESTERHILL
