WE LISTEN



Peter came from humble origins and worked as a Galilean fisherman with his brother Andrew. They were followers of John the Baptist and were the first two disciples to follow Jesus.

Peter followed Jesus faithfully through Jesus' ministry, but when it came to his trial and crucifixion, Peter turned his back on Jesus, denying him three times (even though he told Jesus he would never do such a thing). Regardless of this, Peter got over his guilt and shame at denying the Son of God, and went on to become the leader of the Church and the first Pope within the Catholic faith.



After Pentecost, Peter became the leader of the apostles and travelled through Palestine and Asia Minor where he worked multiple miracles and converted many followers.

St Peter is said to be born around 1 BC and died around 64AD. He was crucified in Rome by Emperor Nero.

Saint Isidore of Seville - AD560-636

Saint Isidore of Seville was born in Cartagena, Spain. He was dedicated to saving and preserving information, which back then was harder to find. He gathered information passed down through generations during a time that was called "the dark ages" - when many factors disrupted learning and information. Isidore created Etymologiae which was one of the first encyclopedias. This made knowledge more accessible to Christians. He is the patron saint of the internet because of his contributions to keeping knowledge.

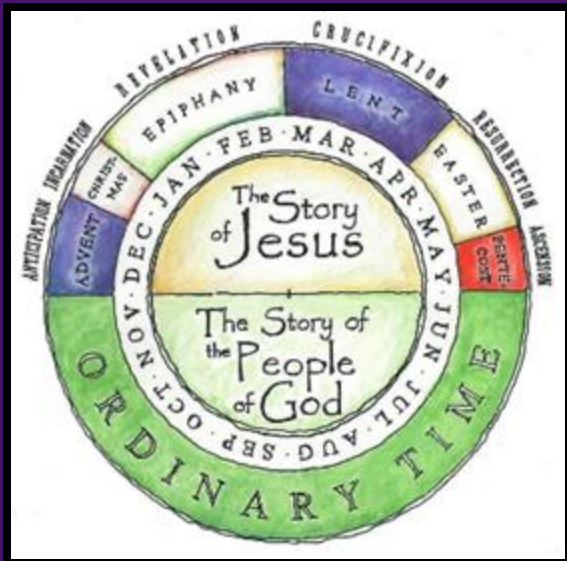

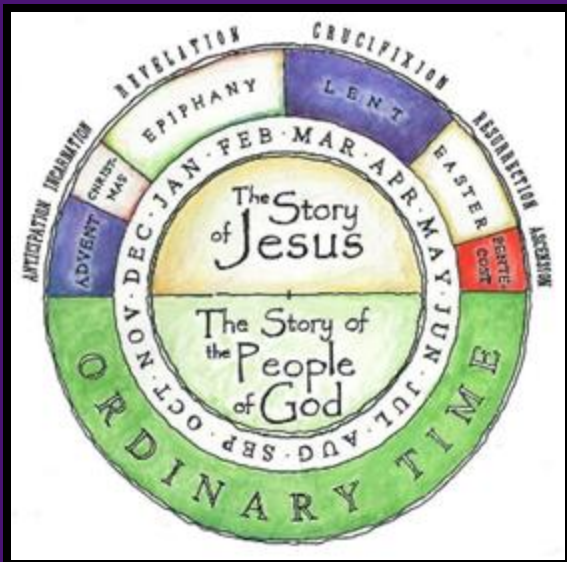
