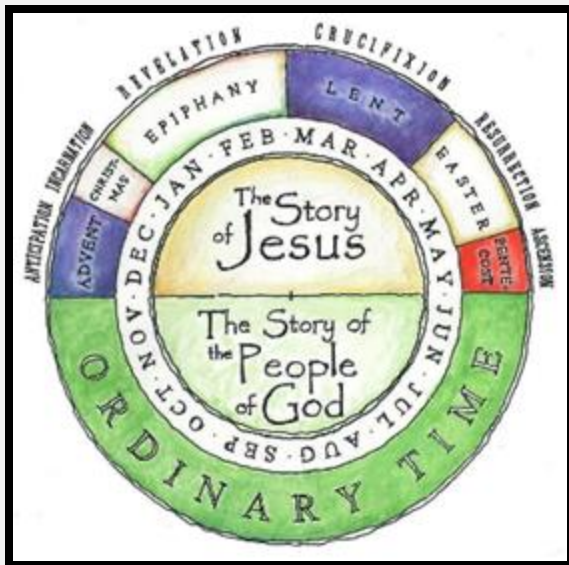

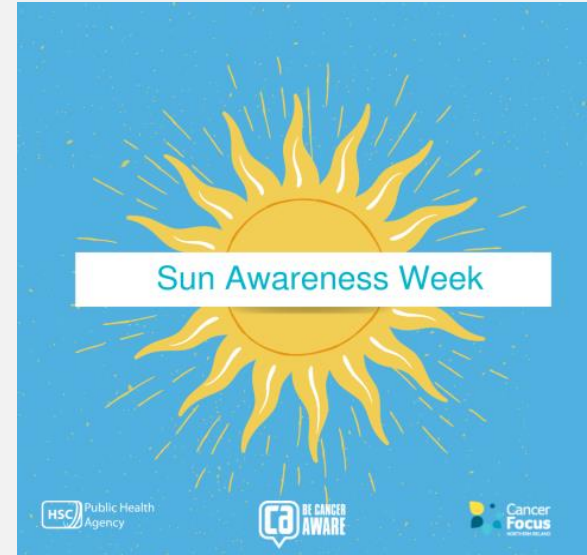
POPE FRANCIS DIARY QUOTE OF THE WEEK

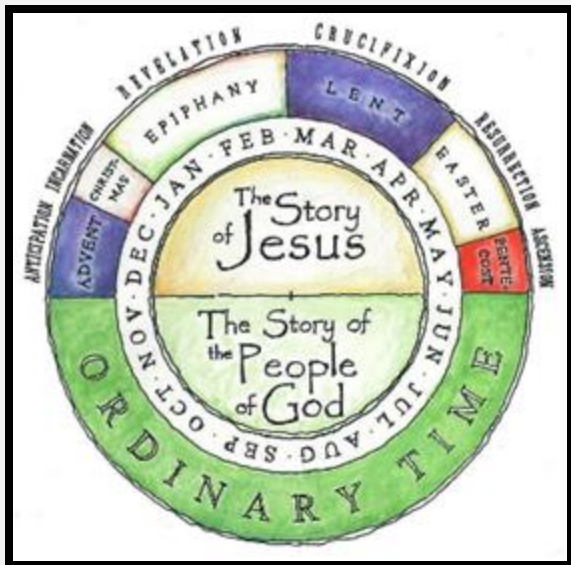

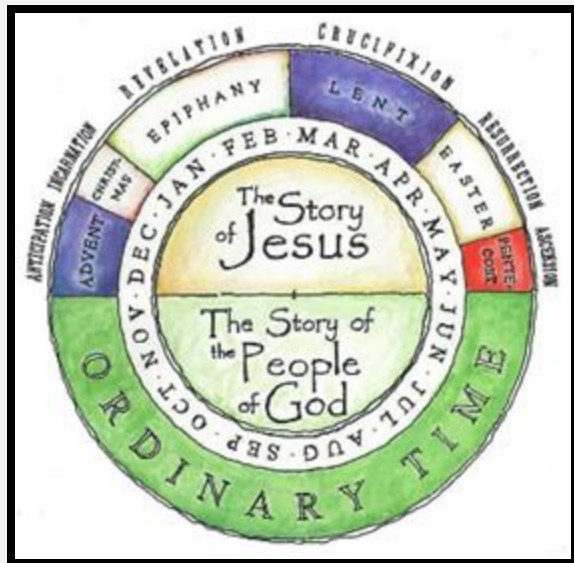

The 80th anniversary of VE (Victory in Europe) Day marks eight decades since the official end of World War II in Europe, when Nazi Germany unconditionally surrendered to the Allied forces in 1945.

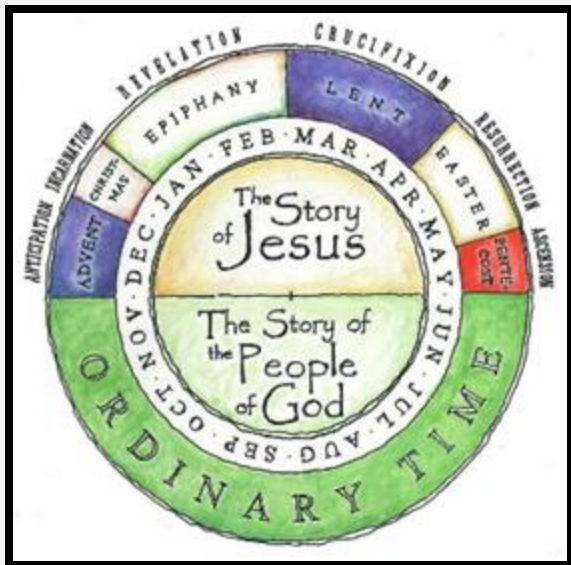

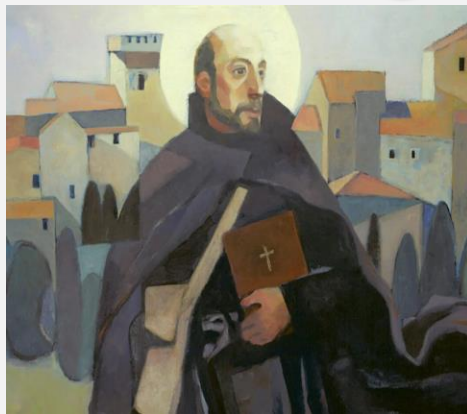

Examen Closing Prayer (1)
