








We must learn from Mary, and we must imitate her unconditional readiness to receive Christ in her life.

In 2015 Pope Francis wrote the encyclical 'Laudato Si' which is all about Care for our Common Home. Within this document, Pope Francis criticises consumerism and irresponsible economic development, laments environmental degradation and global warming, and calls all people of the world to take "swift and unified global action". He continues by saying that instead of viewing humanity as having "dominion" over the earth, we must see that everything is interconnected and that all of creation is a "kind of universal family". Nature cannot be seen as something apart from humanity, or merely the place where we live. He says that our social and environmental crises are thus one complex crisis that must be solved holistically. We need to look after our world a everything in it as it was a gift from God.
