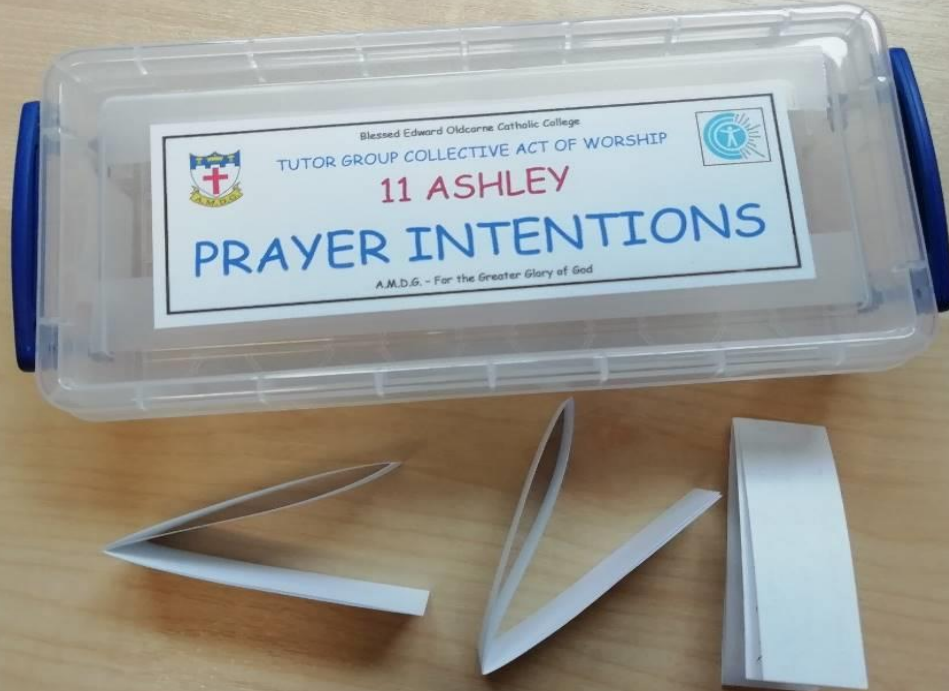
# WE LISTEN



In 2015 Pope Francis wrote the encyclical '*Laudato Si*' which is all about Care for our Common Home. Within this document, Pope Francis criticises consumerism and irresponsible economic development, laments environmental degradation and global warming, and calls all people of the world to take "swift and unified global action". He continues by saying that instead of viewing humanity as having "dominion" over the earth, we must see that everything is interconnected and that all of creation is a "kind of universal family". Nature cannot be seen as something apart from humanity, or merely the place where we live. He says that our social and environmental crises are thus one complex crisis that must be solved holistically. We need to look after our world and everything in it as it was a gift from God.

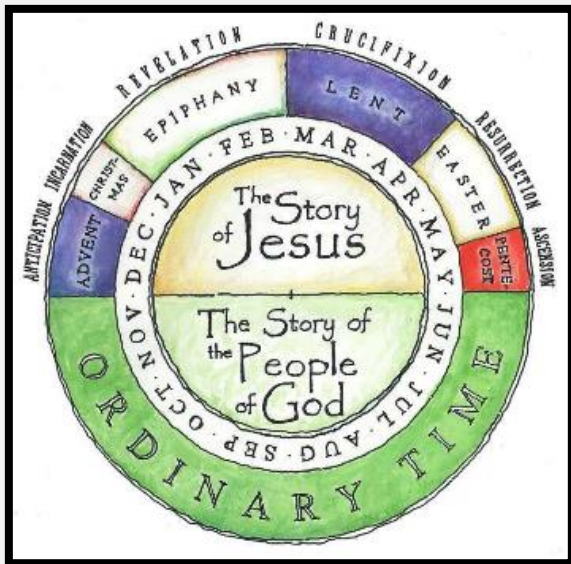

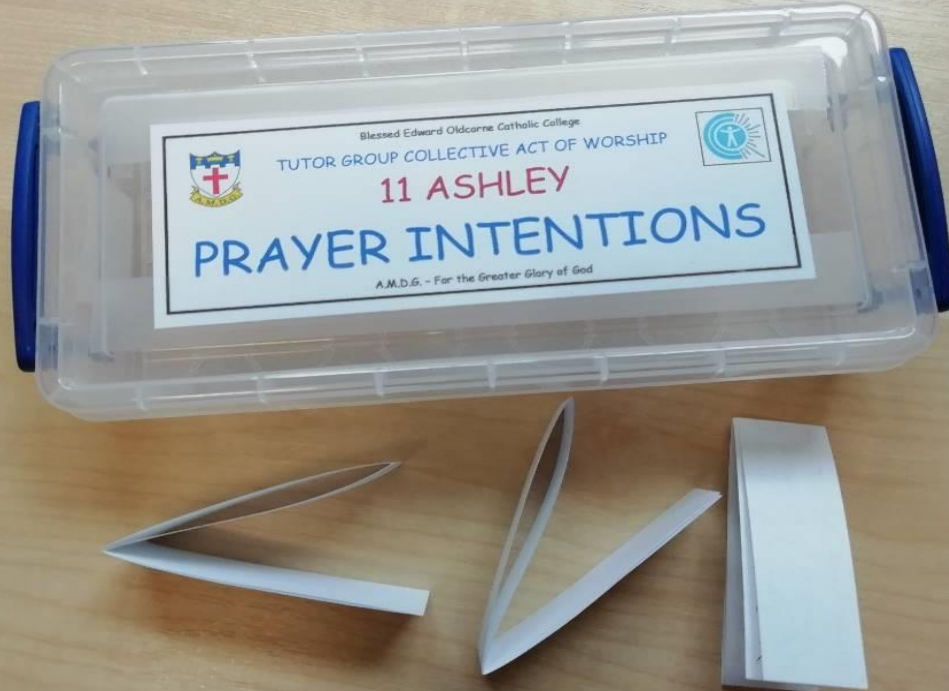


# WE LISTEN

Mary has a significant role within the Catholic Church which the CCC stating that *"The Churches devotion to the Blessed Virgin is intrinsic to Christian worship"*. Catholics even have prayers dedicated to her such as the Hail Mary. This prayer originates from two Bible passages in the Gospel of Luke where an Angel visits Mary (the Annunciation) and Mary's subsequent visit to Elisabeth (Mary's cousin, the Visitation). It is a prayer of praise and petition with an appeal for her intercession on our behalf.

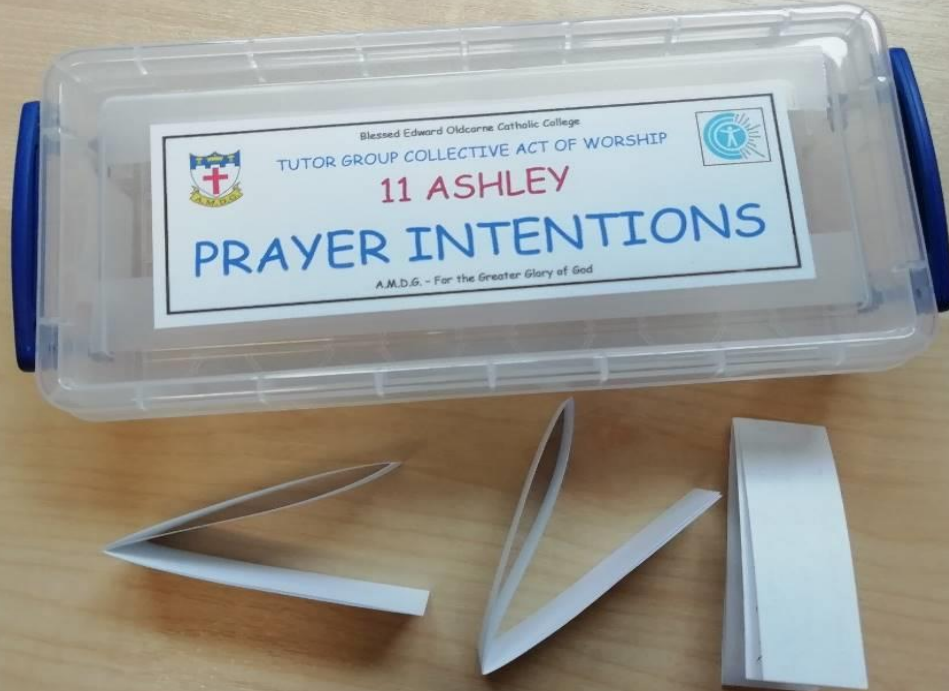
## Examen Closing Prayer (2)
