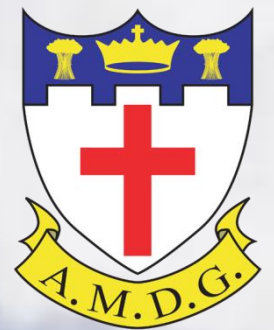

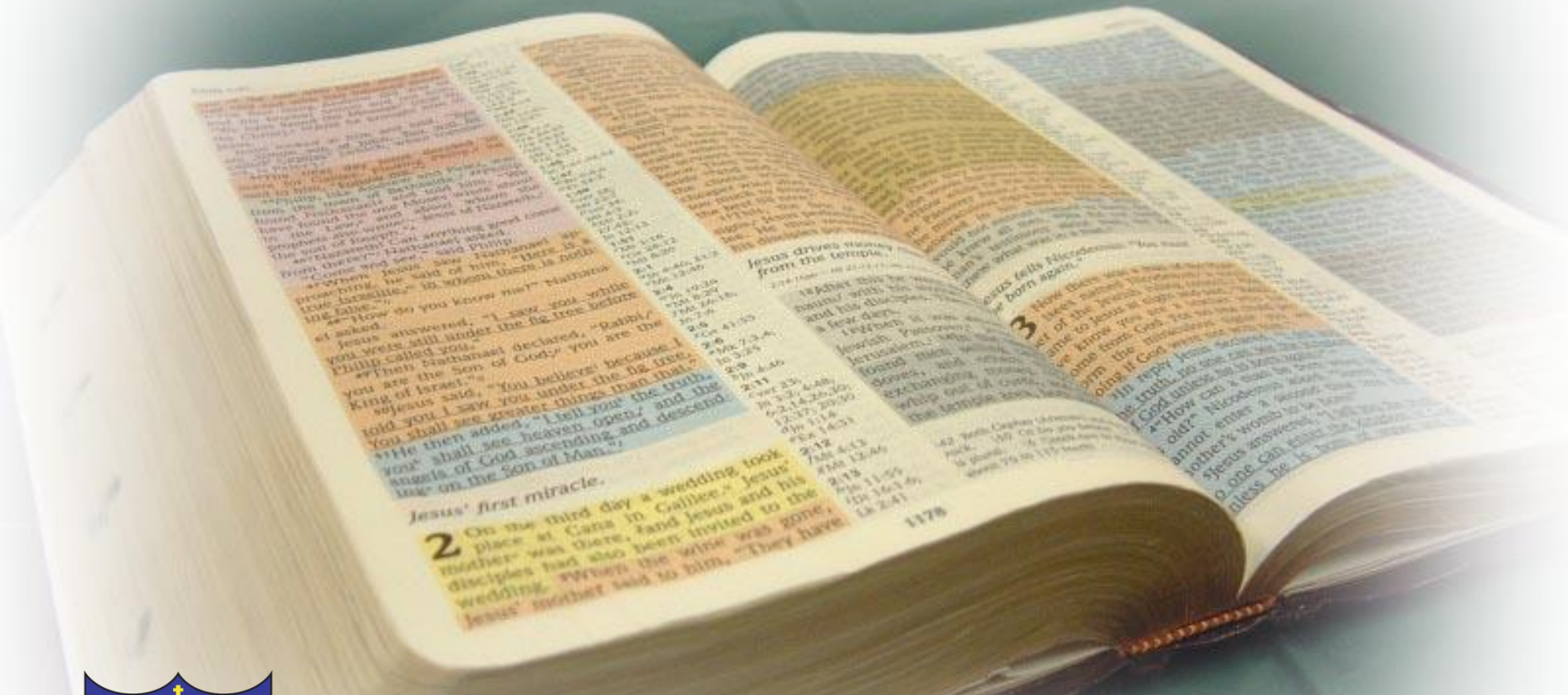

Therefore, the Bible is The Word of God and this helps us to know how God wants us to live.

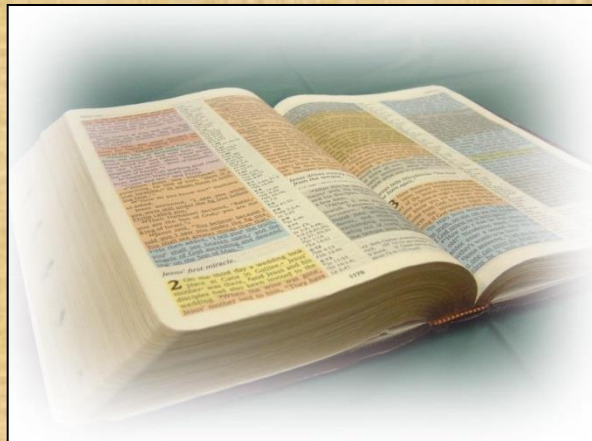

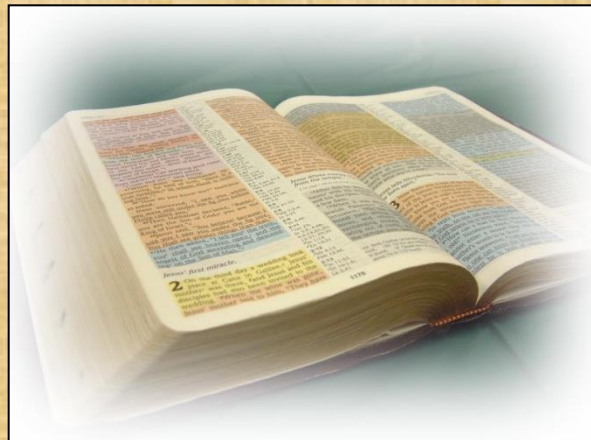

in kindness; in the Holy Spirit;



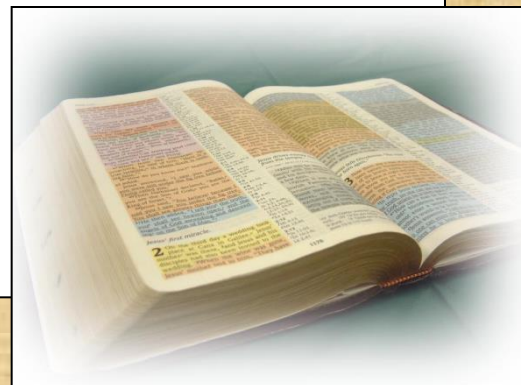
