





in kindness; in the Holy Spirit;




In a love free of affectation; in the word of truth and in the power of God; by using the weapons of uprightness for attack and for defence; in times of honour or disgrace; blame or praise;

May all who dedicate their lives to sharing and living the Gospel of Love find their reward in the Kingdom of God.






4. We pray for everyone attending this Mass today.

5. Next Monday is Holocaust Memorial Day and we remember the six million Jewish people who died under Nazi oppression during World War Two.


We can never expect to understand this horror as we ask for your mercy and justice to reign in the world today.

We will now <u>share communion together</u> by either receiving the Body of Jesus or a blessing.


