
Welcome to our Ash Wednesday Service.


It marks the beginning of the EPIPHANY Season of Lent. ANTICIPATION The Story of It lasts for 6 weeks and ends during Holy Week.

PANCAKE DAY!



THE DAY BEFORE ASH WEDNESDAY IS CALLED 'SHROVE TUESDAY'





Shrove Tuesday (Pancake Day), is the feast before the start of Lent.

All the 'fattening' ingredients in the home were used up and pancakes were made.

The word 'Shrove' comes from the word 'Shriven' meaning absolution of sins.

In preparation for Lent, Anglo-Saxon Christians went to <u>confession</u> on Shrove Tuesday and were 'shriven' (absolved from their sins).



Once Lent has begun there is a tradition of <u>fasting for 40 days</u> up until the joyous events of Easter.

WELISTEN



For <u>forty days</u>, we accompany Jesus on his journey to Calvary and see the mercy that he shows towards others despite his suffering.

This Lent we are also making our journey alongside families around the world living in poverty, especially those who do not have the basic needs of water, clothing or shelter.

That is why we commit ourselves to some outreach and charity work at this time.

By observing the 40 days of Lent, <u>Christians replicate</u> Jesus' sacrifice and withdrawal into the desert for 40 days. He fasted and prayed <u>before beginning his work for God</u>.





SCRIPTURE FOCUS

A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO MATTHEW

Your Father, who sees all that is done in secret, will reward you.

Jesus said to his disciples:

'Be careful not to parade your good deeds before men to attract their notice; by doing this you will lose all rewards from your Father in heaven.

So, when you give alms, do not have it trumpeted before you; this is what the hypocrites do in the synagogues and in the streets to win men's admiration.

I tell you solemnly, they have had their reward.

But when you give alms, your left hand must not know what your right is doing; your almsgiving must be secret, and your Father who sees all that is done in secret will reward you.

'And when you pray, do not imitate the hypocrites: they love to say their prayers standing up in the synagogues and at the street corners for people to see them.


I tell you solemnly, they have had their reward.
But when you pray go to your private room and,
when you have shut your door,
pray to your Father who is in that secret place,
and your Father who sees all that is done in secret will
reward you.

'When you fast do not put on a gloomy look as the hypocrites do: they pull long faces to let men know they are fasting.

I tell you solemnly, they have had their reward.
But when you fast, put oil on your head and wash your face,
so that no one will know you are fasting except your Father
who sees all that is done in secret;
and your Father who sees all that is done in secret will
reward you.'

The wearing of ashes is an ancient ceremony.

The ashes symbolise Penance and Contrition.



They remind us that God is Merciful to those who call on him with Repentant hearts.







REMEMBER

Unlike its discipline regarding sacraments, the Catholic Church <u>does not exclude anyone</u> from receiving the Ashes.

Ashes are <u>not a sacrament</u> and do not signify communion of faith beyond a need for <u>repentance</u> and a remembrance of <u>mortality</u>.





While only a priest or deacon may bless the ashes,

laypeople may do the placing of the ashes on a person's head.

Let us all <u>SAY TOGETHER</u> a special <u>PRAYER</u> over the ashes.

Lord, may these ashes be a sign to us that our Lent has begun.

Bless us during this time of Lenten preparation.

Help us to keep our promises to fast, motivate us to use our talents wisely and guide us to pray and become closer to you.

Strengthen us so that we may be transformed, body, soul and mind, ready to celebrate the great feast of Easter.

ASHES DISTRIBUTION



The ashes will now be distributed.

The <u>Cross of Ashes</u> tells our friends and neighbours that we know we are <u>NOT PERFECT</u>.

However, they are also a powerful sign that we will try to become better people during the Season of Lent.

ASH WEDNESDAY



The person distributing the ashes will say the words -

REPENT, TURN AWAY FROM SIN, AND KNOW THAT YOU ARE LOVED.

When you return to your seat, sit quietly and reflect on your personal Lenten promises.


