Close your eyes... then barely open them!




MAKE ME HOLY LORD




Today we reflect upon the wonderful gift of forgiveness.

At times we may <u>find it hard to forgive</u> someone who has hurt or offended us in anyway.

Let us all now sit still and listen to a well-known <u>parable</u> from Matthew's Gospel.

In it, we hear the story of the 'Unforgiving Servant'.



THE UNFORGIVING SERVANT

Matthew 18:15-35

PARABLE

A simple story,
with a hidden meaning,
used by Jesus to illustrate
a spiritual lesson.

THE UNFORGIVING SERVANT

Peter - Yes, I know you have said it is very important to forgive; but it's hard.

Anyway, what do you do if someone offends you again, and again?

Do you forgive them as many as seven times?

Jesus - Oh, no, Peter, not seven times.

More like seventy times seven times.

Those who follow me, who want to be part of the Kingdom of God, must be generous in forgiving.

It's rather like this story...

<u>Clerk</u> - Your majesty, I have been checking the annual accounts, as you ordered and find that one of your servants has not repaid the large loan you made him a year ago.

King - Go and find this man and bring him to me.

Are the rest of my accounts in order?

Clerk - Yes, Sire. There's a healthy profit.

King - Ah, here you are.

Why have you avoided repaying my loan?

How much do you owe me?

Unforgiving Servant

Much more than I can afford to repay, your highness.


King - How much?

Unforgiving Servant

A <u>hundred thousand</u> pounds! Sire. Please have mercy....

I have no way of repaying you. Think of my family who will be without food and clothing if you imprison me.

Please, please have mercy.




King - I could sell you and your family as slaves.
That would raise some of what you owe.
Then I could let you off...

<u>Unforgiving Servant</u> - Please, Sire, please give me more time.

King - No... I will not give you more time.

But as I am feeling merciful today, I will cancel your debt. Go back to your family and don't get into debt again. Unforgiving Servant - Thank you, thank you Sire.
You are magnificent and generous.
Thank you.



Unforgiving Servant

Oi, you! Yes you! Come here a minute.

Servant 2

Do you mean me?

Unforgiving Servant


Yes, you. Where's my money? You owe me ten pounds.

Servant 2

Please give me time.

I've not got ten pounds on me.

I'll get it for you tomorrow.



Unforgiving Servant

I want it now! Now, do you hear!

Servant 3

Leave him alone. Give him a bit of time.

Unforgiving Servant

You keep out of this, or you'll be sorry! Guard, here.

Take this fellow off to prison.

He owes me money.

Servant 3 - Your highness, may we speak with you?

<u>King</u> - You may. What troubles you?



Servant 3


Sire, you remember how this morning, in your goodness you forgave the debt of the servant who owed you a vast sum of money?

King - Yes, I do.

Servant 3

Well, he has had one of his friends thrown in prison for owing him just <u>ten</u> pounds!

Yes, I was there and saw it all.



THE UNFORGIVING SERVANT

Matthew 18:15-35

King - Go and get him!

You did well to tell me of this.


I shall see that this unforgiving servant is severely punished.

King - You evil man.

I cancelled your huge debt to me because you begged and pleaded.

Could you not have forgiven your fellow servant such a <u>small sum</u>, just as I forgave you?

King - You are utterly evil.
 Hand him over to the guards.
 He can stay in prison until the whole debt is repaid.



Jesus

That is what your heavenly Father expects, Peter.

We must all be generous in forgiving one another.





WERESPOND



The story we have just heard, really brings home the <u>importance</u> of being <u>forgiving</u>.

The lesson from the Parable of the Unforgiving Servant is that we <u>must forgive others</u> their sin against us if we want <u>our sins</u> against God to be forgiven.

Let us now <u>examine our own hearts and minds</u> and accept that we too commit sin.

THE SERVANT AVOIDS REPAYING HIS LOAN




Are you good at avoiding things you know you should be doing?

Are you guilty of bullying someone?


Do you <u>spread stories</u> about people?

THE SERVANTS GO AND TELL THE KING WHAT HAS HAPPENED




Do you always tell the truth?

Think again of that one person one thing that you thought of at the start of the service...


IN THE SILENCE OF YOUR HEART

Just be honest about it and say sorry.




