On Easter Day we celebrate with joy as we remember the first Easter when Jesus rose from the dead.

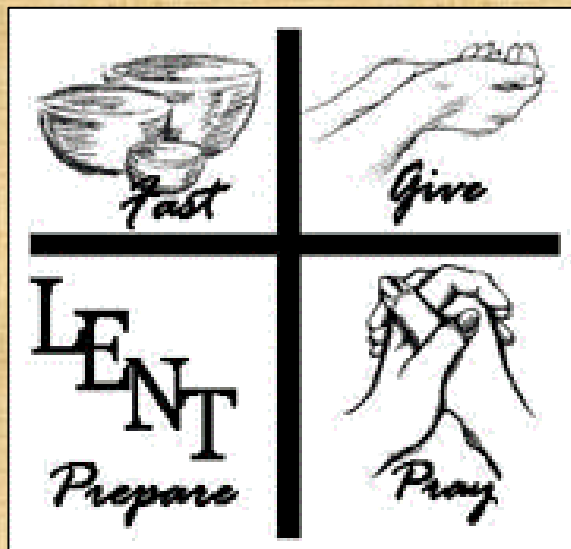




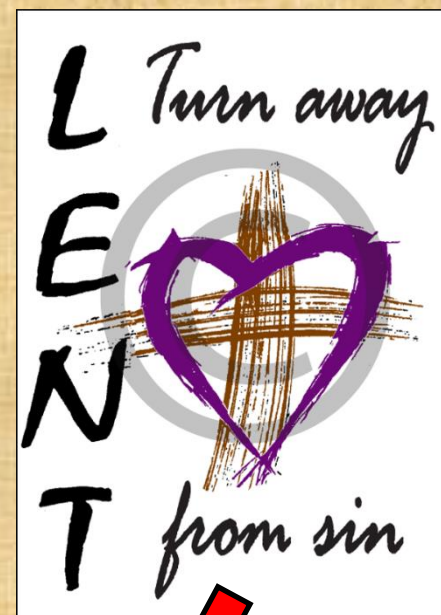

JESUS IS SENTENCED TO DEATH

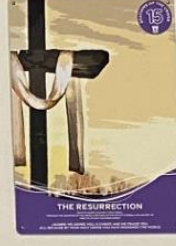
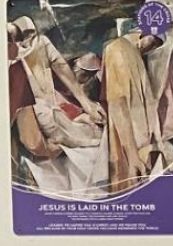
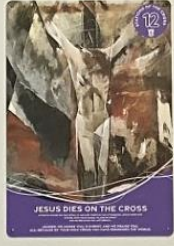
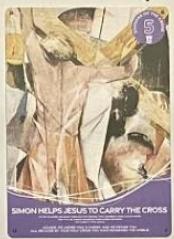
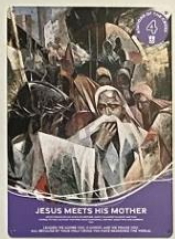
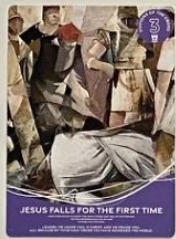
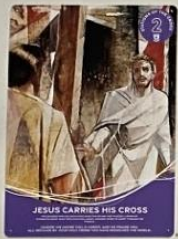
