






<u>Welcome</u> to our End of Year Celebration Mass as we prepare ourselves to <u>get closer to God</u>.


As we gather in worship, we are reminded of our unity as God's chosen people.

We pray that our school will continue to flourish helping to develop people of good character.







# THE WELISTEN




During the Liturgy of the Word we hear the proclamation of <u>Sacred scripture</u>.

# COMMUNION




We will now share communion together by either receiving the <u>Body of Jesus or a blessing</u>.



## THIS IS COMMUNION


This is communion, Your body broken




