The "Parable of the Talents", in Matthew 25:14-30 tells of a master who was leaving his house to travel, and, before leaving, entrusted his property to his servants. According to the abilities of each man, one servant received five talents, the second had received two, and the third received only one.

The one who received five talents, doubled his. The one who received two talents, doubled his. The one who received only one buried his and did nothing with it. When the master returned he was angry with the servant who had buried his talent.

This teaches us the importance of trying to improve our talents and not to hide them away.

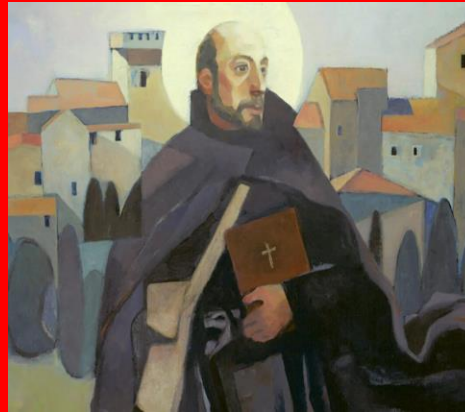
# WE LISTEN

This weekend, the Church celebrates the Feast of Corpus Christi, also known as the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, is a Catholic celebration honouring the **real presence** of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. It serves as a public affirmation of this belief, often involving processions and community gatherings to honour the sacrament. This feast also encourages deeper reflection and devotion to the Eucharist among the faithful.
