





What gifts and talents do you have? Do you hide them away or do you show your gifts and talents to others? Do you try to improve your gifts and talents?

The "Parable of the Talents", in Matthew 25:14-30 tells of a master who was leaving his house to travel, and, before leaving, entrusted his property to his servants. According to the abilities of each man, one servant received five talents, the second had received two, and the third received only one.

The one who received five talents, doubled his. The one who received two talents, doubled his. The one who received only one buried his and did nothing with it. When the master returned he was angry with the servant who had buried his talent.

This teaches us the importance of trying to improve our talents and not to hide them away
