# WE LISTEN


Today, the church celebrates the Feast of Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. In Catholic churches and homes, one of the most popular images of Jesus is the image of the Sacred Heart.. It is the image of God's love revealed in the pierced heart of his Son. It is the symbol of a love that conquers sin and transcends death, the symbol of the One who loved us to the end.

Devotion to the Sacred Heart is devotion to Jesus and his love. It is a sign or a symbol of both the divine and human love that Jesus has for his Father and for us.
