Nine months before St Oscar Romero was killed while saying Mass, he told the people in El Salvador that they are witnesses to Jesus. Listen to his words.

"If some day they take away from us our Catholic radio station, if they close down our newspaper, if they don't allow us to speak, if they kill all the priests and the bishop, too, and you are left - a people without priests - then each one of you must be God's microphone, a messenger, a prophet. The Church will always exist even if there is only one baptised person. That one baptised person would be responsible before the world for holding up high the banner of the Lord's truth and justice."





Pope Francis has made significant contributions to the Catholic faith since his election in 2013. He issued the encyclical Laudato si', which emphasizes the importance of environmental stewardship and addressing the climate crisis. He has also worked to promote unity among different faiths and has made historic apologies to survivors of clergy sexual abuse. Additionally, Pope Francis has focused on pastoral care, including outreach to remarried and LGBT Catholics. His efforts to reform the Church include tightening doctrines on the death penalty and just war theory.

O God, shepherd and ruler of all the faithful, look favorably on your servant Francis, whom you have set at the head of your Church as her shepherd;

Grant, we pray, that by word and example he may be of service to those over whom he presides so that, together with the flock entrusted to his care, he may come to everlasting life.
