

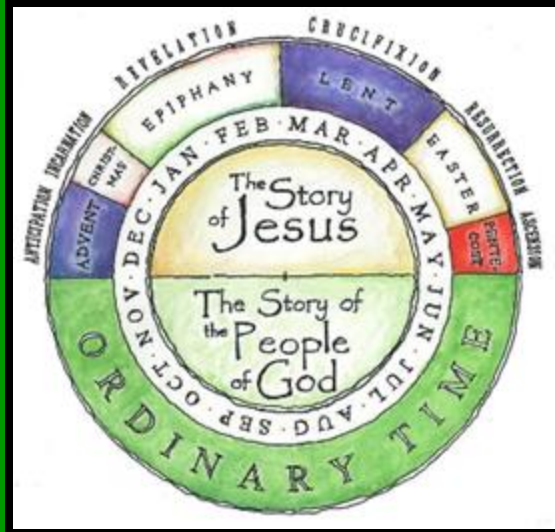

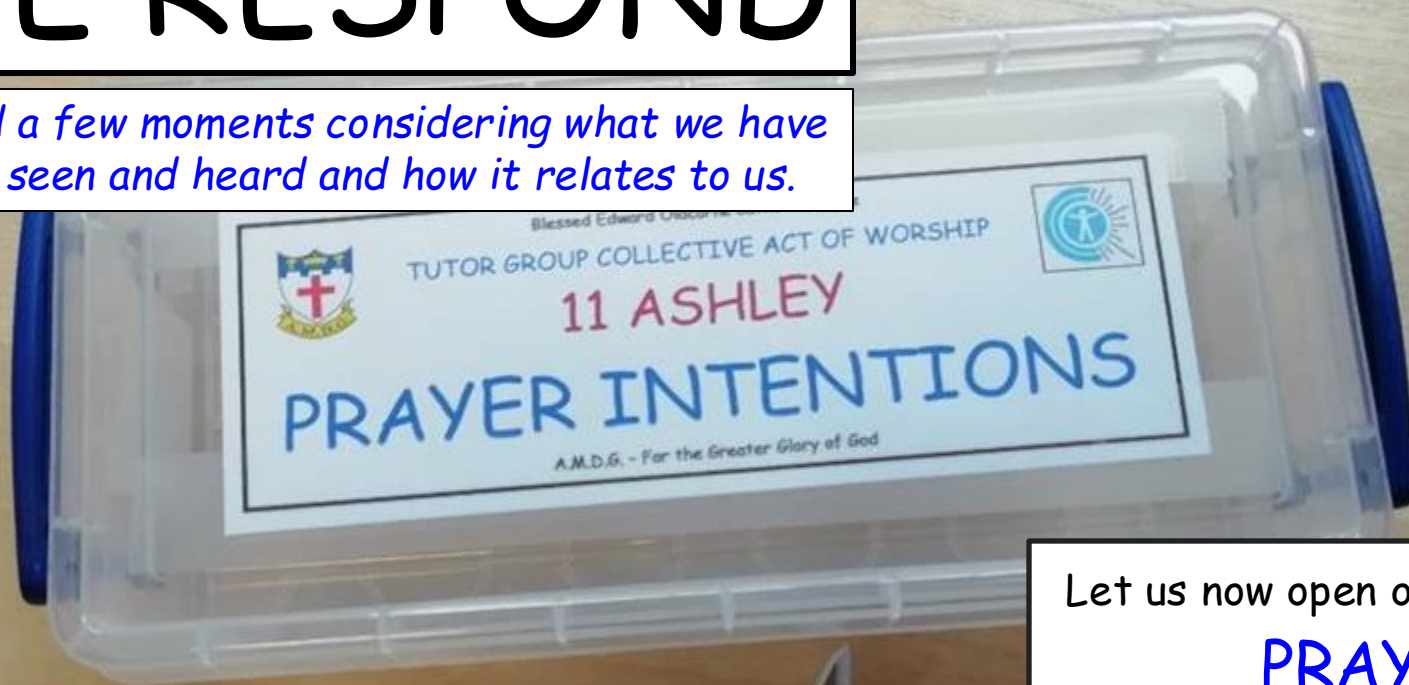
Gabriel announced to Zachariah the forthcoming birth of John the Baptist, and to Mary, the birth of Jesus.

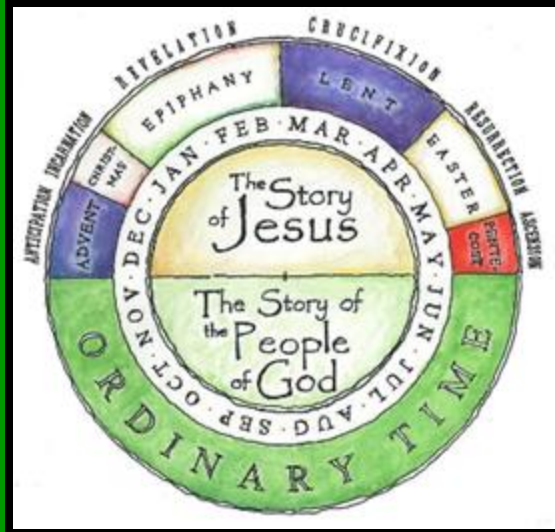

Saint Vincent de Paul has [a charity named after him](#).

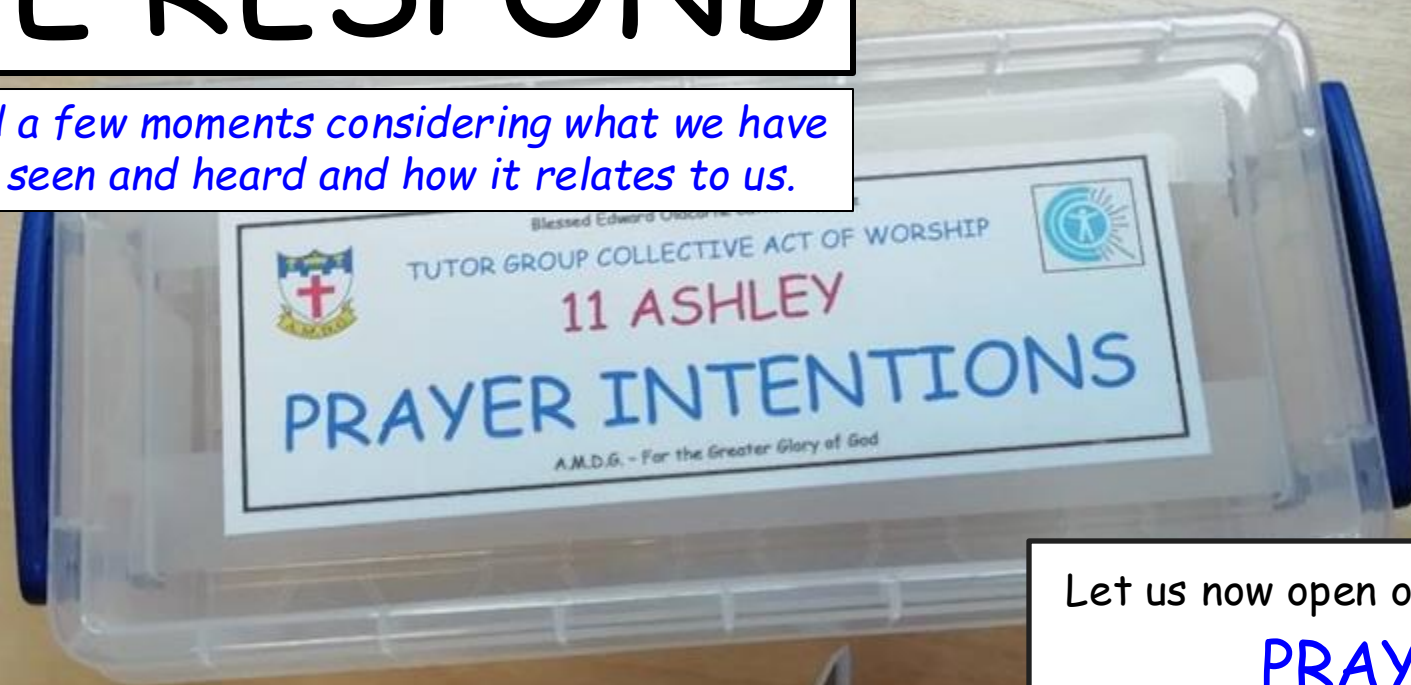
SVP works in local communities, to befriend the lonely, tackle poverty and give practical support to those who need it.

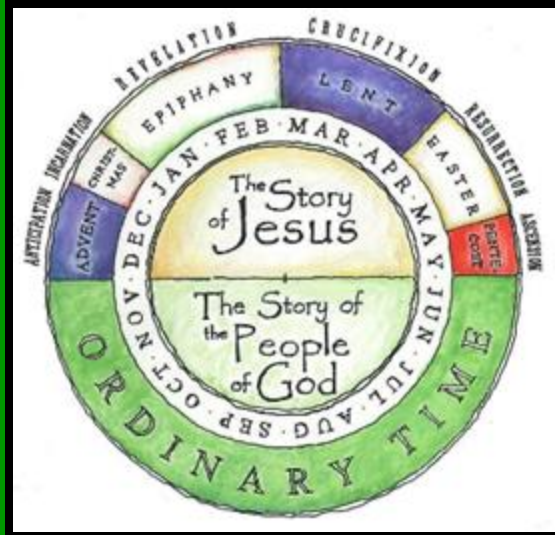

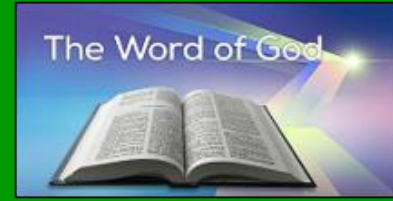

Catholic pray the Mysteries of the Rosary.

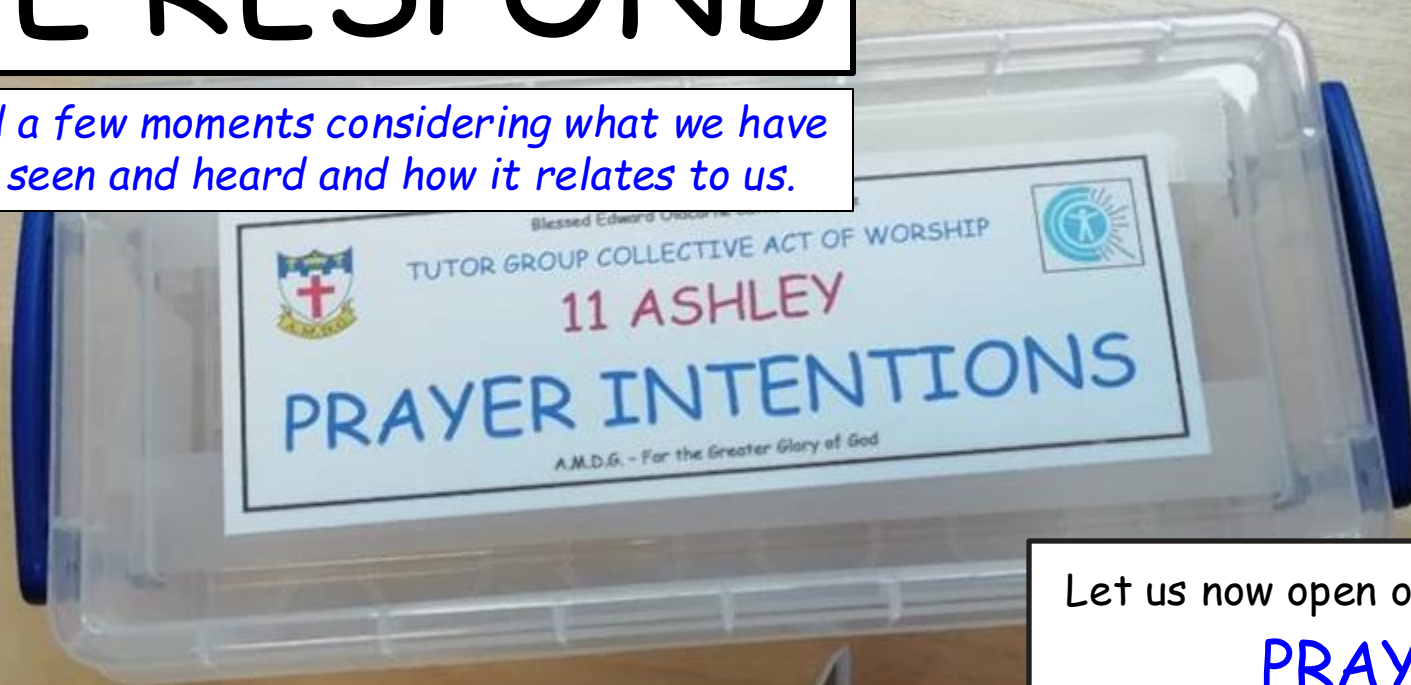
There are four Mysteries: joyful, sorrowful, glorious and luminous.

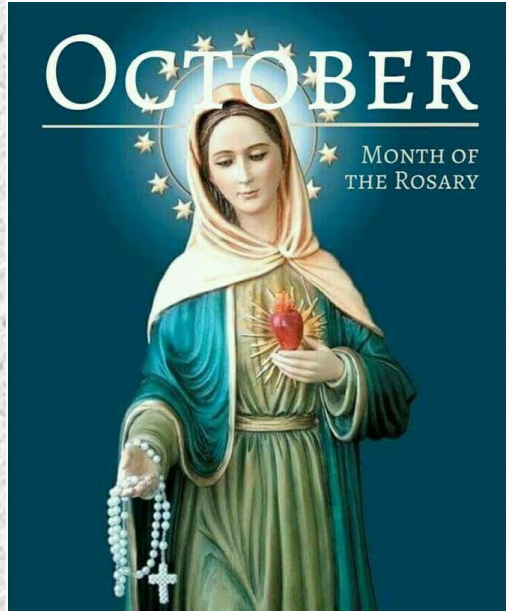

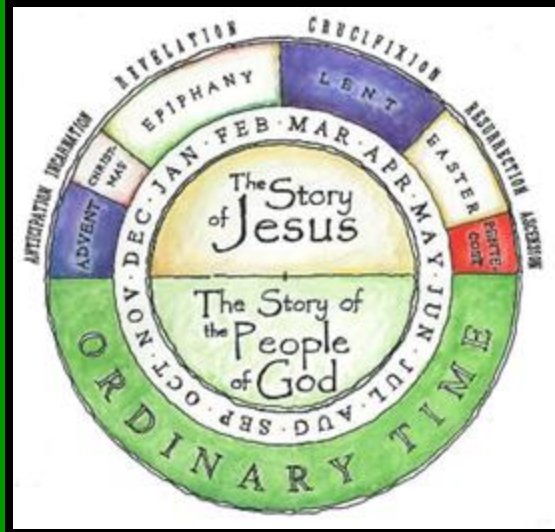

In 2019 Pope Francis reaffirmed this by designating October as an Extraordinary Month of Mission (EMM).

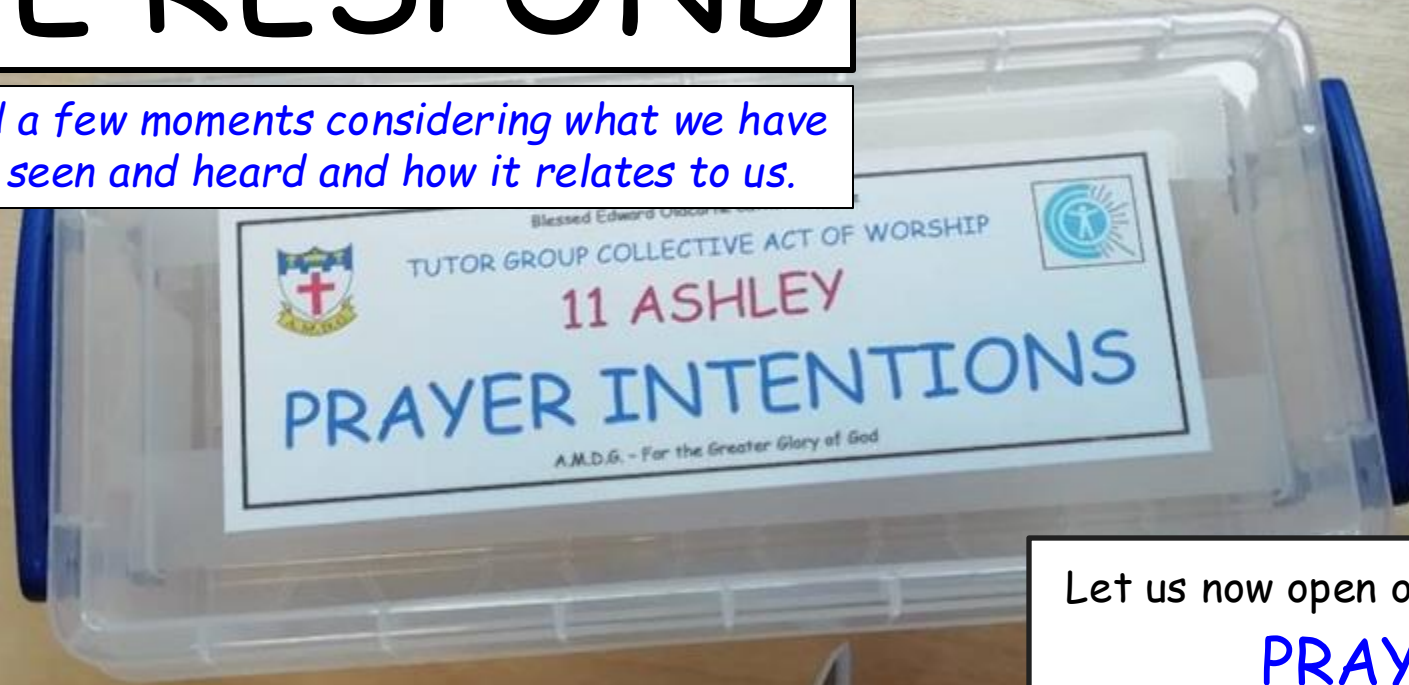


EMM's aim was to encourage all members of the Catholic community to recognise themselves as missionary disciples, praying together to share God's love with everyone everywhere.

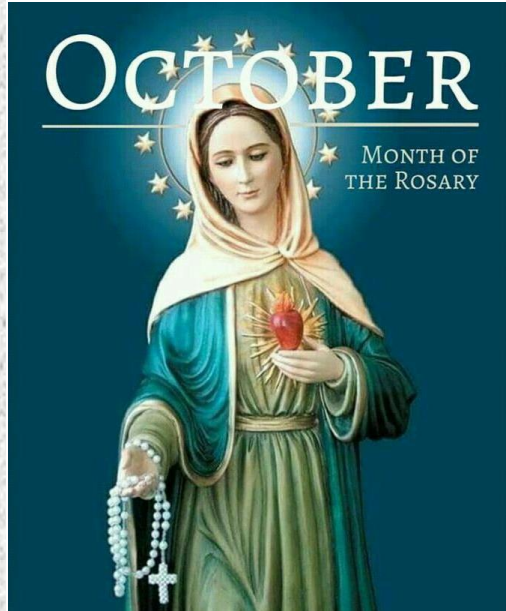

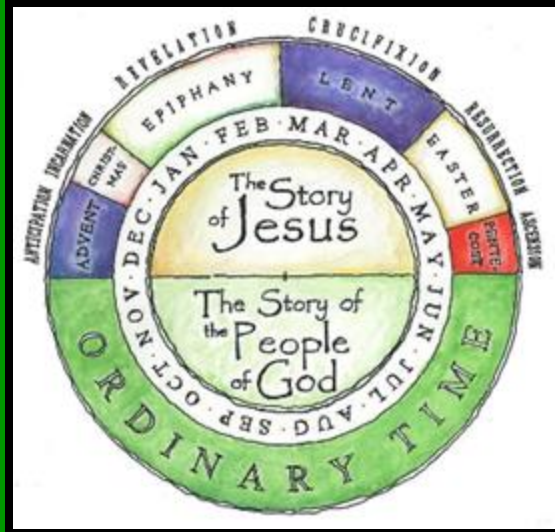

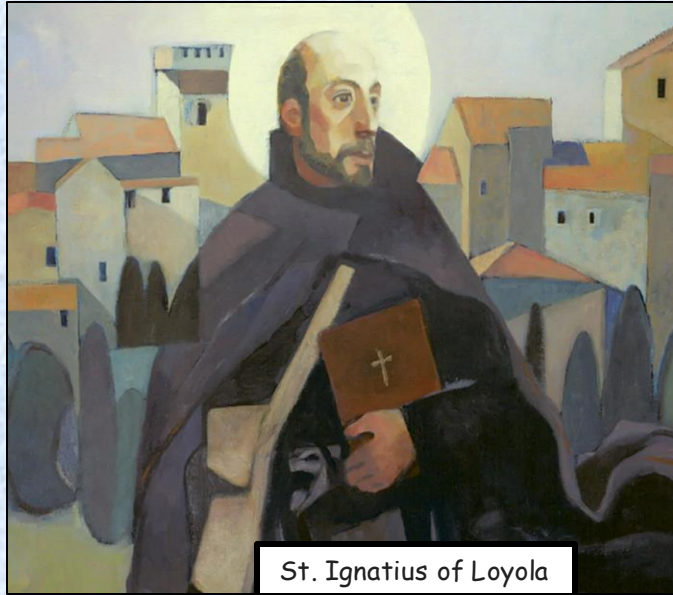

Please free my thinking and feelings and the thinking and feelings of others, from all forms of self-will, self-centeredness, dishonesty, and deception.

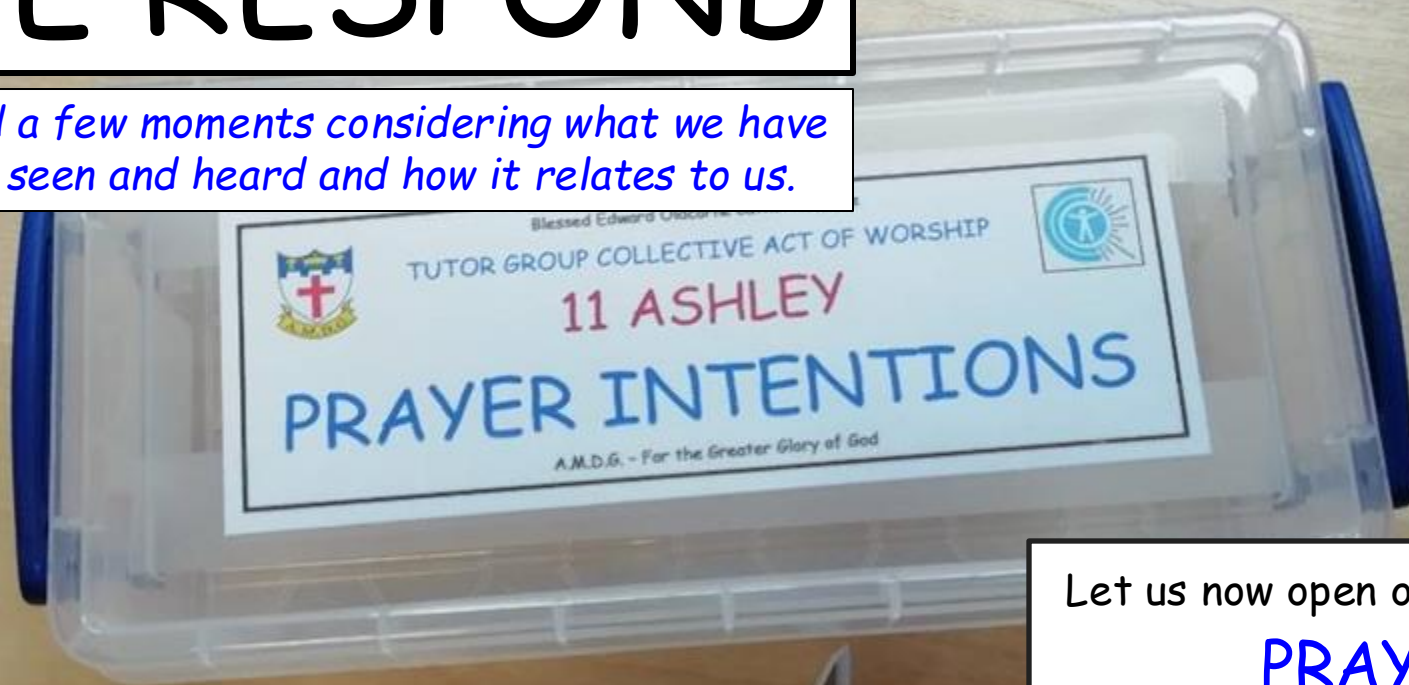
Along with my brothers and sisters, I need this freedom to make my choices today according to your desires.

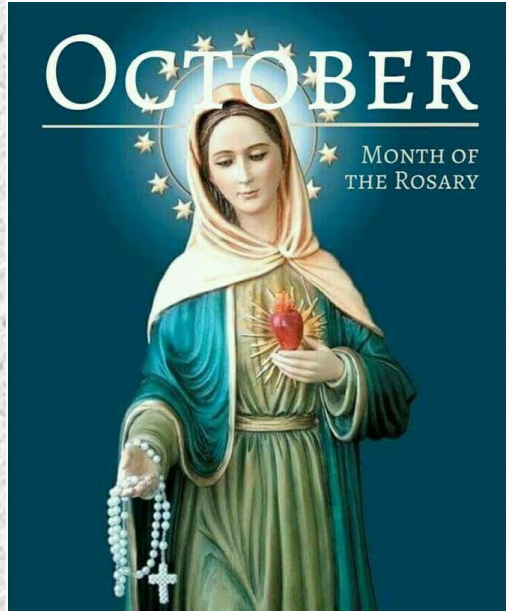
