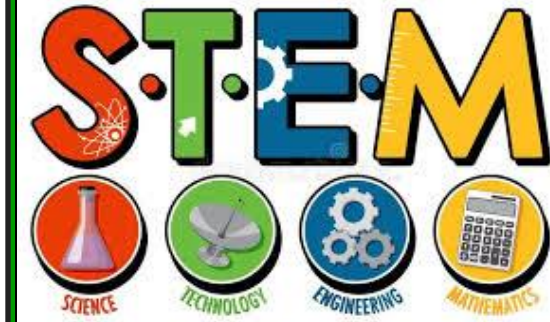
# THE WORD



[Ada Lovelace](#) was born in 1815 and collaborated with inventor Charles Babbage on his general purpose computing machine, the Analytical Engine.

In 1843, Lovelace published what we would now call a [computer program](#) to generate Bernoulli Numbers.

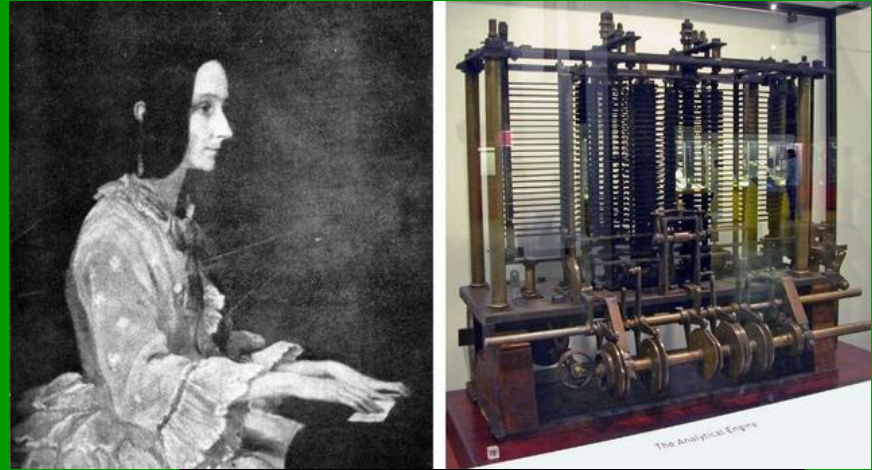
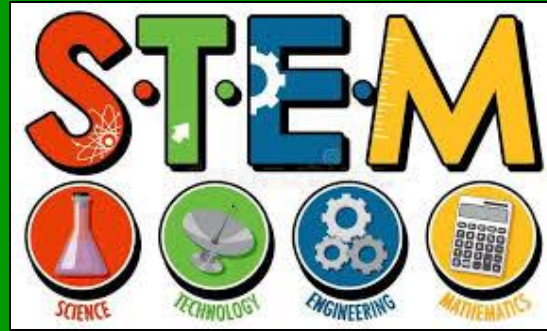
Whilst Babbage had written fragments of programs before, Lovelace's was the most complete, most elaborate and the first published.





Ada Lovelace Day is an international celebration of the achievements of women in science, technology, engineering and maths (STEM).

It aims to increase the profile of women in STEM and, in doing so, create new role models who will encourage more girls into STEM careers and support women already working in STEM.

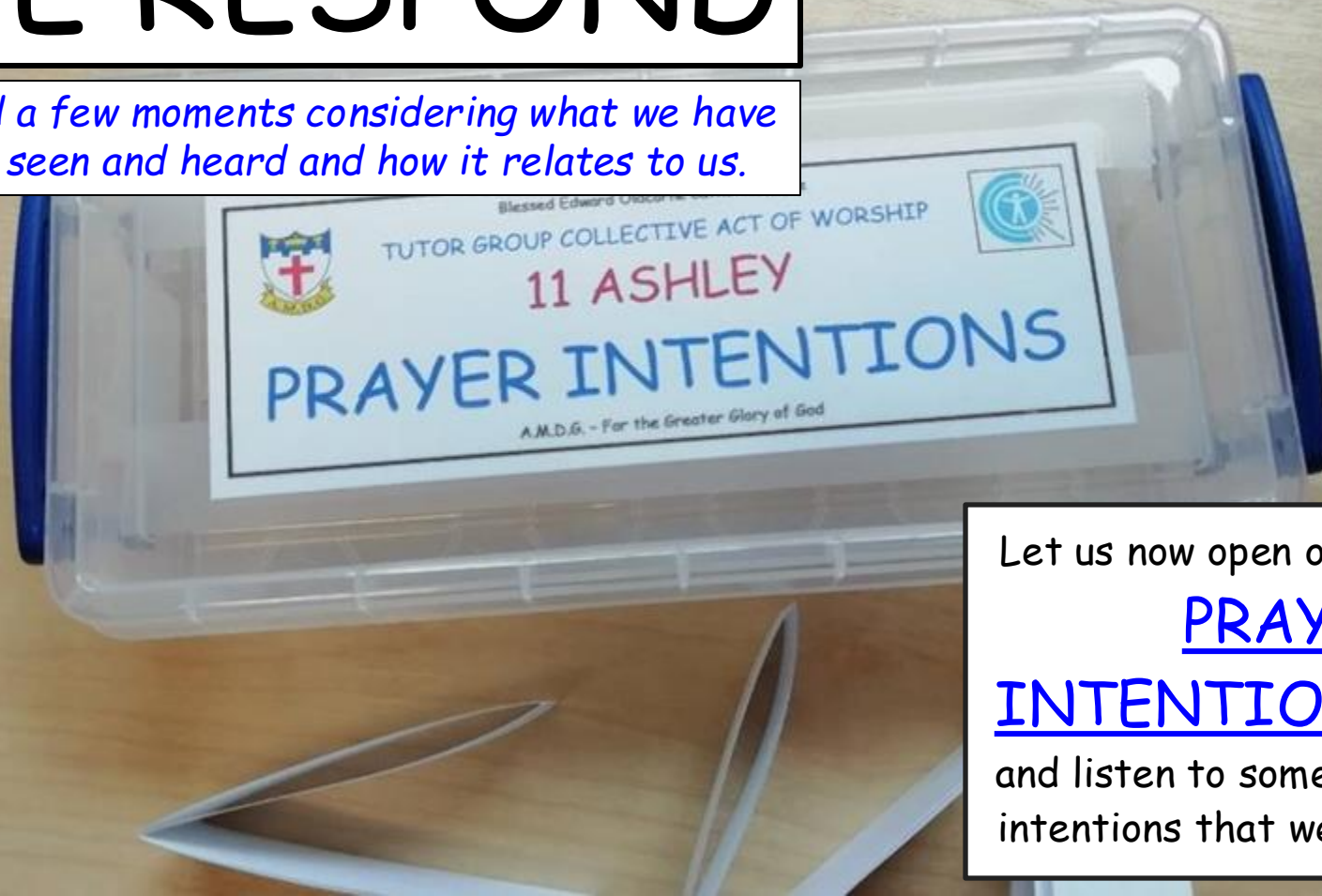

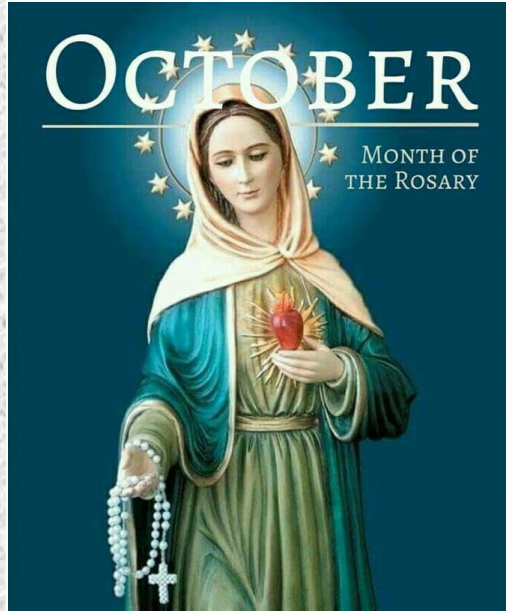

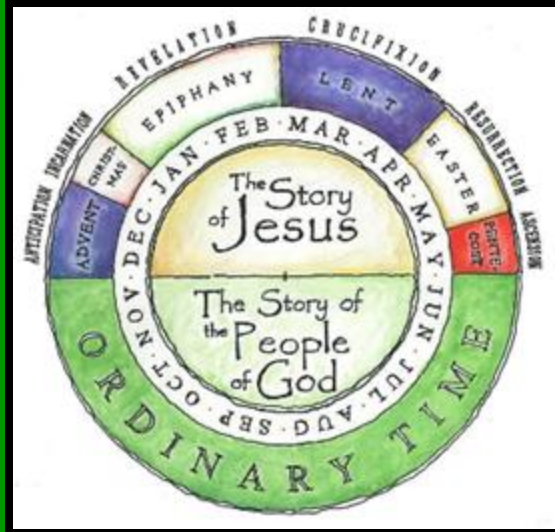

[John Henry Newman](#) was very well known in the Church as a theologian, a teacher and an educationalist.

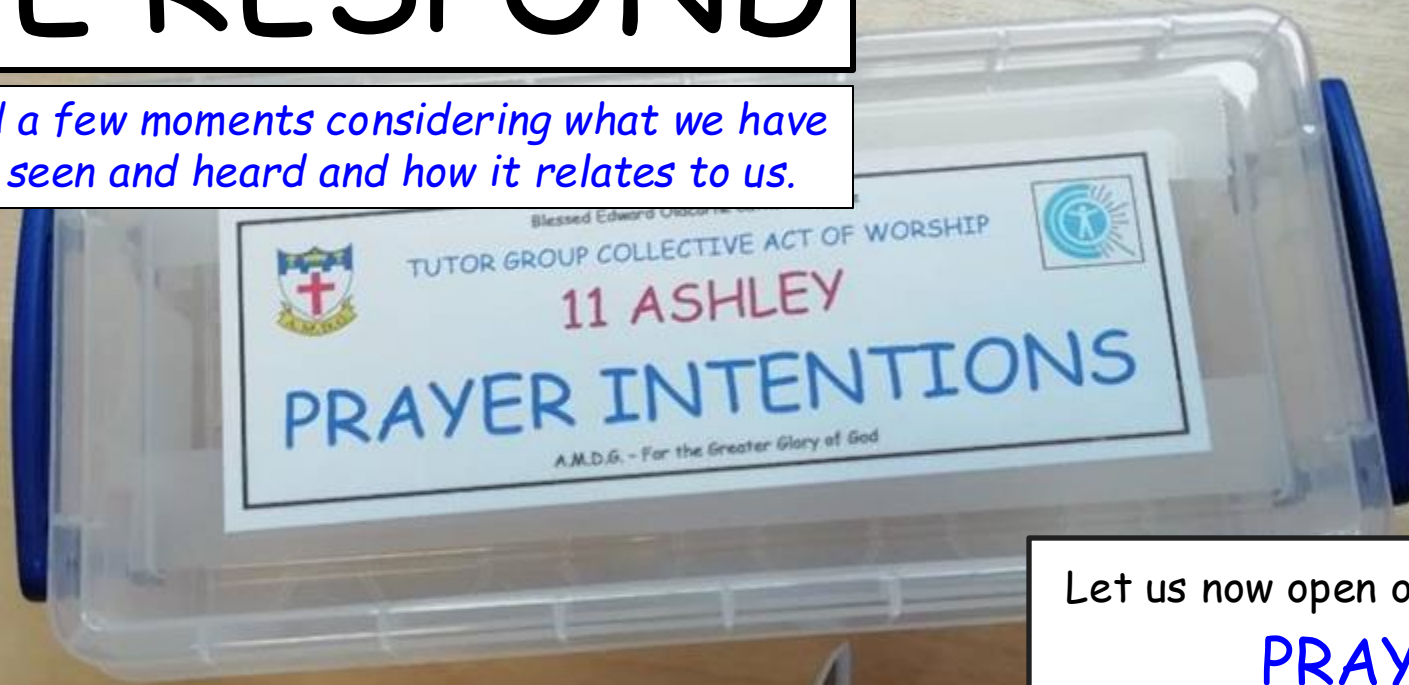

Please free my thinking and feelings and the thinking and feelings of others, from all forms of self-will, self-centeredness, dishonesty, and deception.

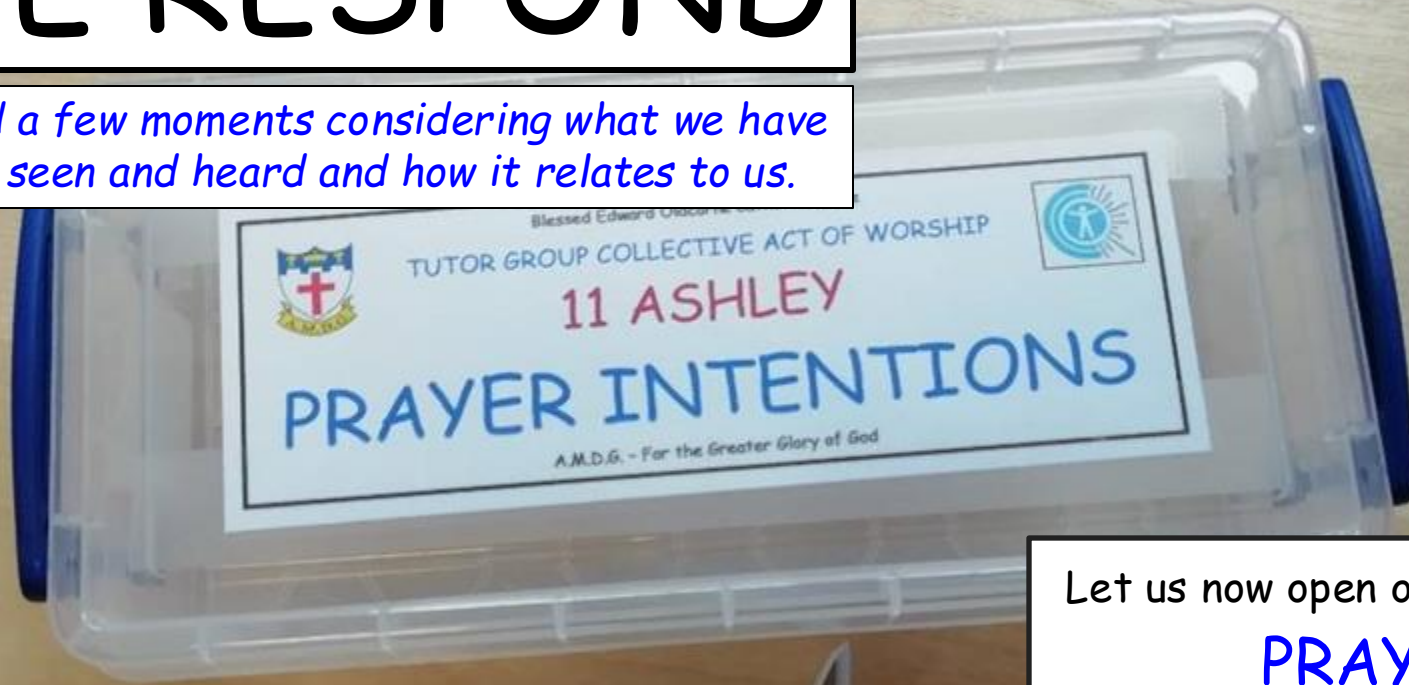
Along with my brothers and sisters, I need this freedom to make my choices today according to your desires.

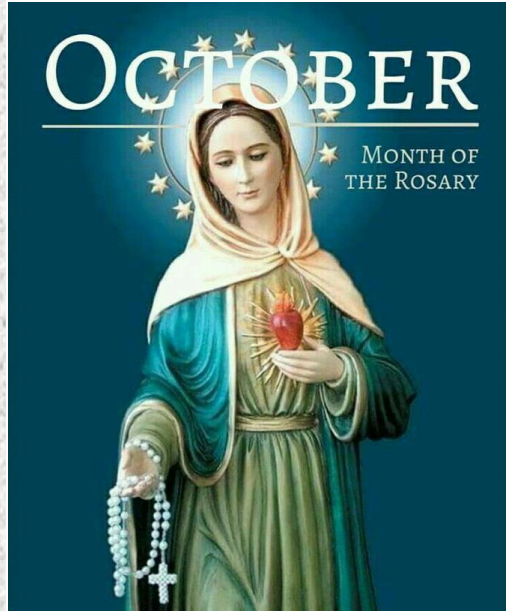
