
THE WORD



Ada Lovelace was born in 1815 and collaborated with inventor Charles Babbage on his general purpose computing machine, the Analytical Engine.


In 1843, Lovelace published what we would now call a <u>computer program</u> to generate Bernoulli Numbers.


Whilst Babbage had written fragments of programs before, Lovelace's was the most complete, most elaborate and the first published.



Ada Lovelace Day is an international <u>celebration of</u> the achievements of women in <u>science</u>, technology, <u>engineering and maths</u> (STEM).

It aims to increase the profile of women in STEM and, in doing so, create new role models who will encourage more girls into STEM careers and support women already working in STEM.
