She was a mystic and author of spiritual writings and poems.

She founded numerous convents throughout Spain and was the originator of the Carmelite Reform that restored a contemplative and austere life to the order.

The heart and the arrow are <u>St. Teresa's symbols</u> because she had a vision that an angel pierced her in the heart with an arrow.

- Teresa was born in Ávila, Spain in 1515
- Saint Teresa suffered from <u>poor health</u> for most of her life, but that did not stop her from filling her every waking hour with productivity
- Teresa founded a total of over thirteen monasteries during her lifetime



She is the <u>Patron Saint</u> of people who suffer from headaches, chess players and makers of lace.
