



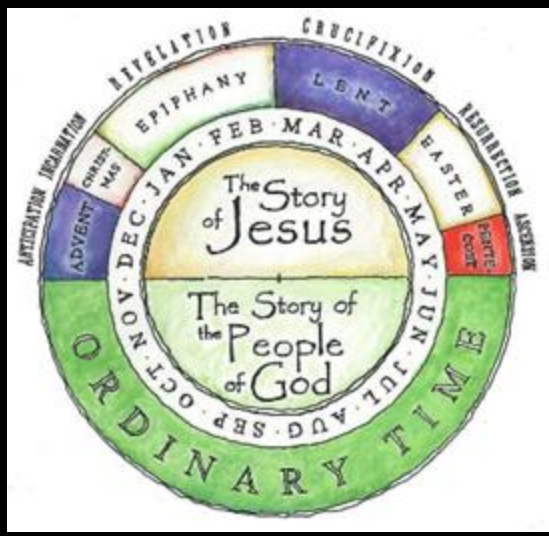

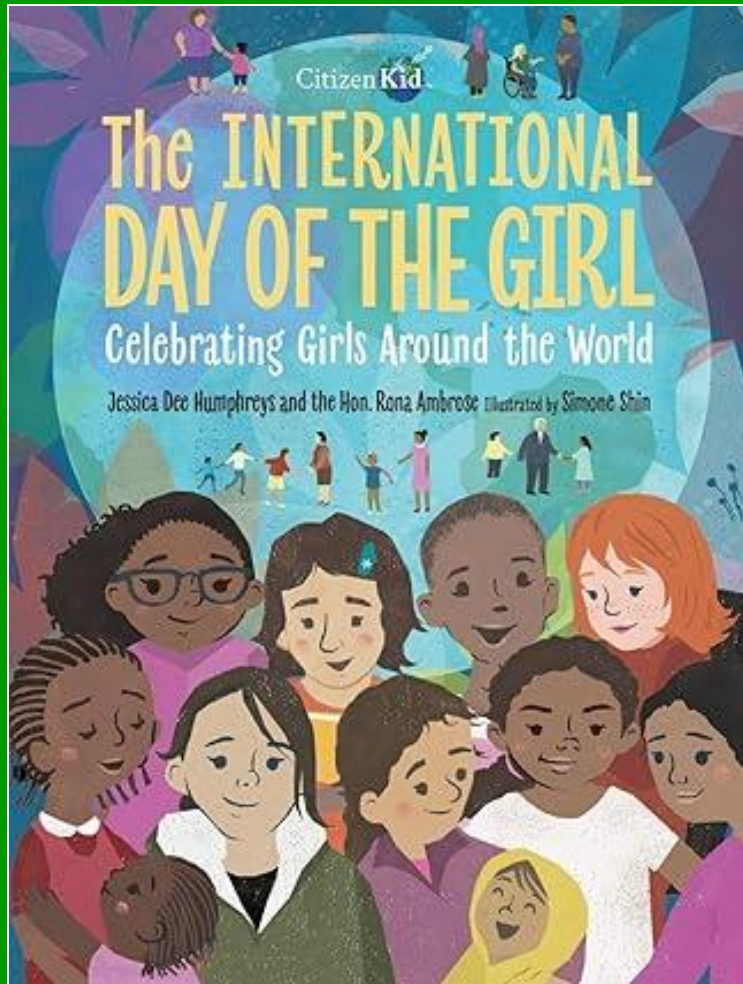

Every day, girls are breaking boundaries and barriers, tackling issues like child marriage, education inequality, violence, climate justice, and inequitable access to healthcare.

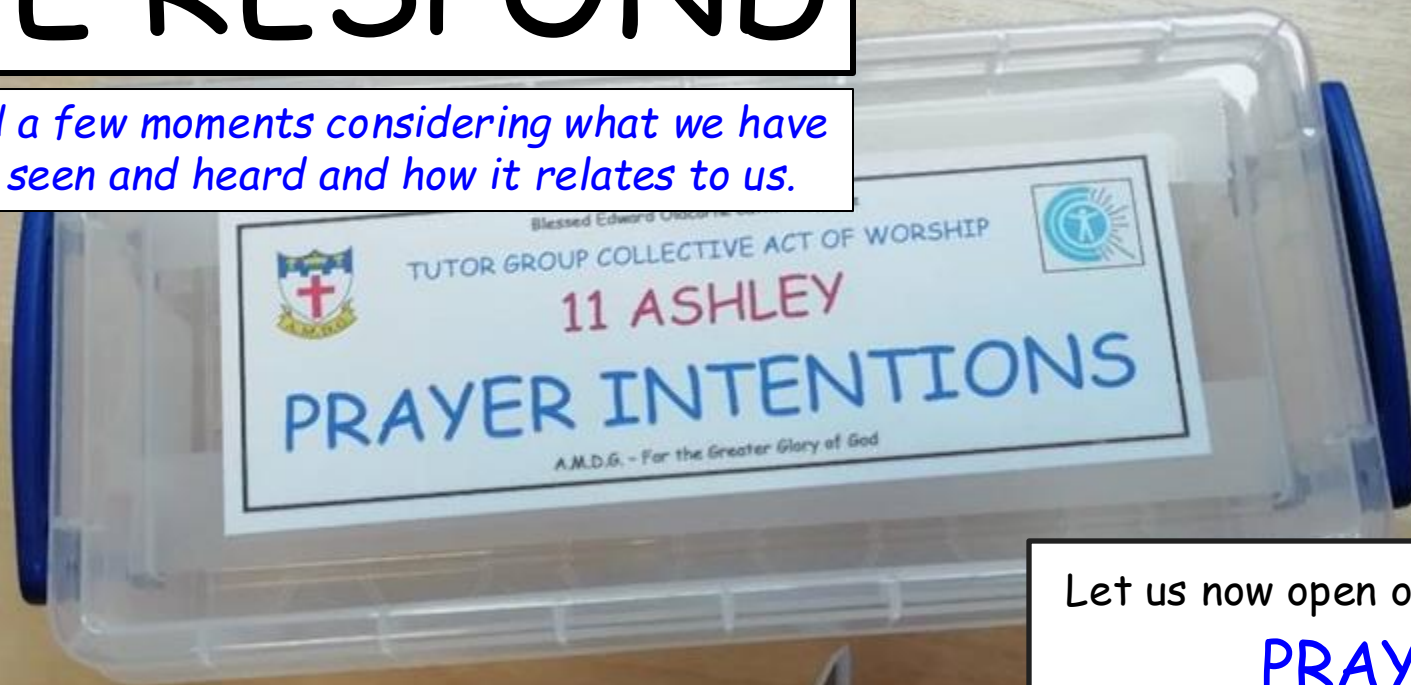

She was a mystic and author of spiritual writings and poems.

She founded numerous convents throughout Spain and was the originator of the Carmelite Reform that restored a contemplative and austere life to the order.

The heart and the arrow are [St. Teresa's symbols](#) because she had a vision that an angel pierced her in the heart with an arrow.



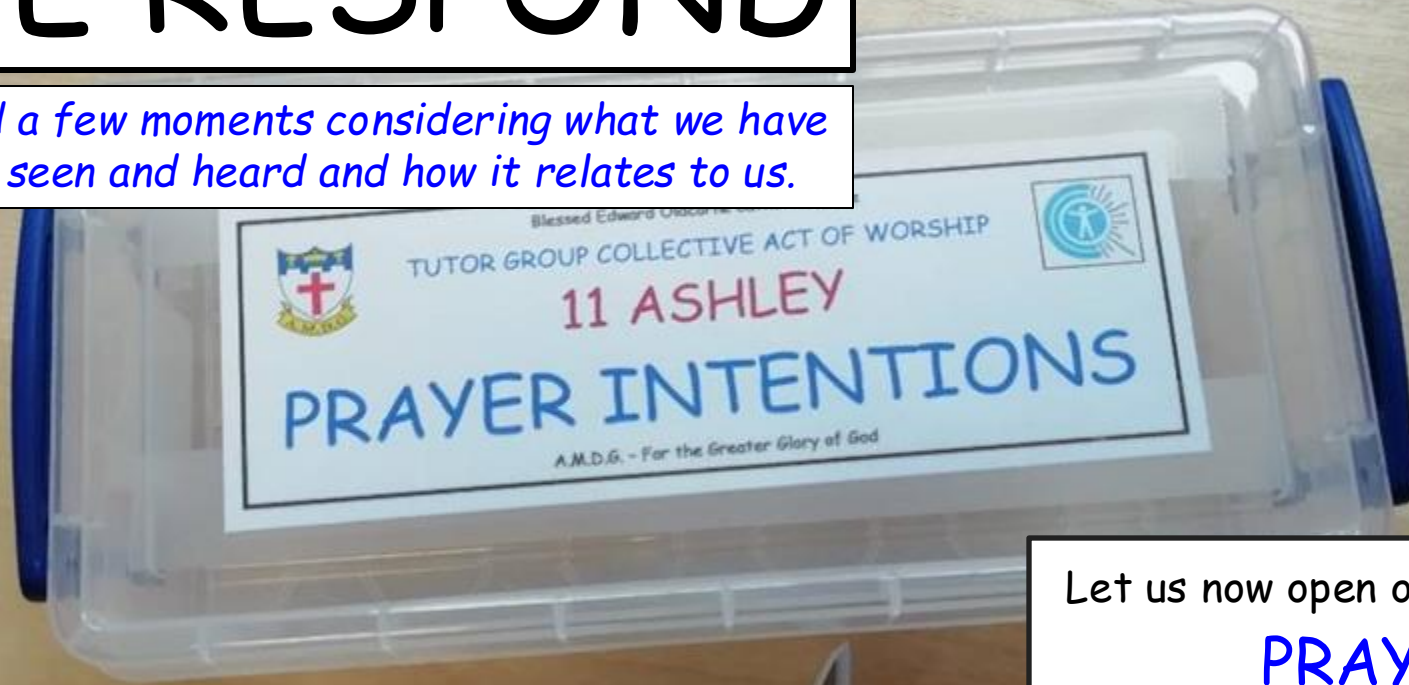
- Teresa was born in Ávila, Spain in 1515
- Saint Teresa suffered from poor health for most of her life, but that did not stop her from filling her every waking hour with productivity
- Teresa founded a total of over thirteen monasteries during her lifetime



She is the Patron Saint of people who suffer from headaches, chess players and makers of lace.

Please free my thinking and feelings and the thinking and feelings of others, from all forms of self-will, self-centeredness, dishonesty, and deception.

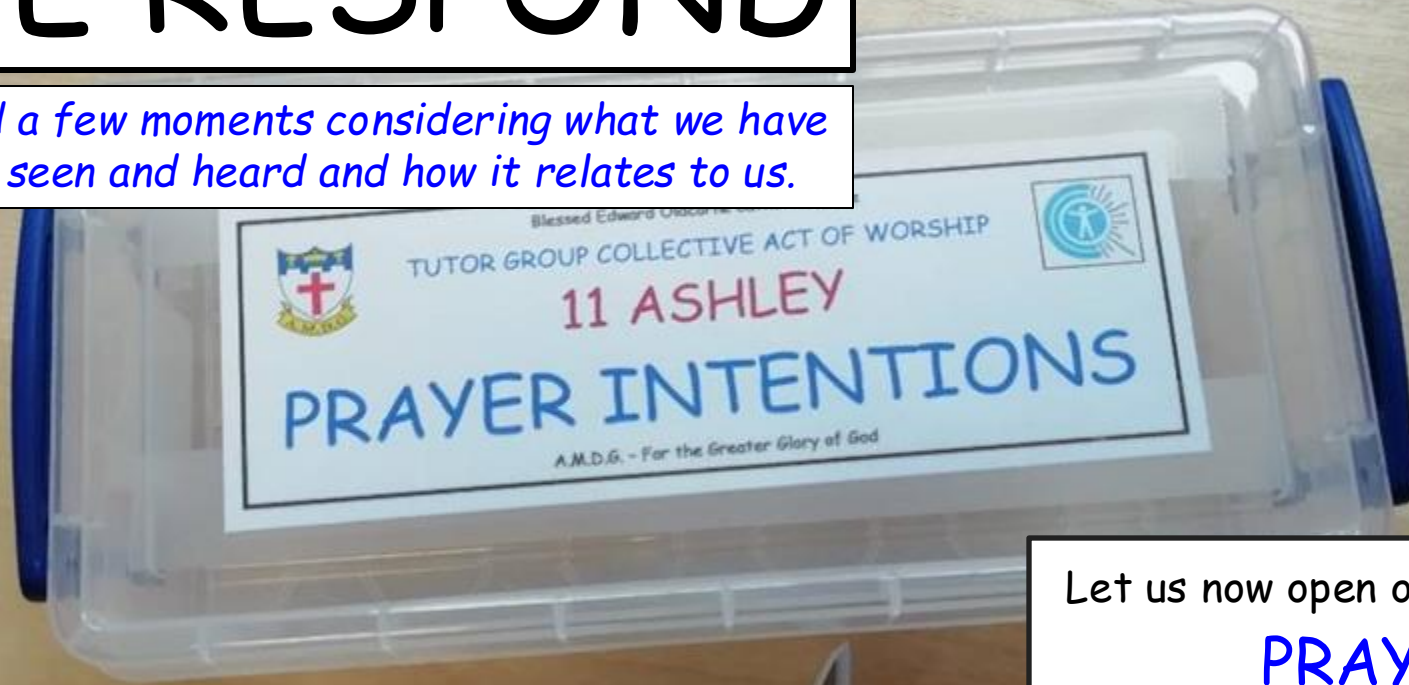
Along with my brothers and sisters, I need this freedom to make my choices today according to your desires.

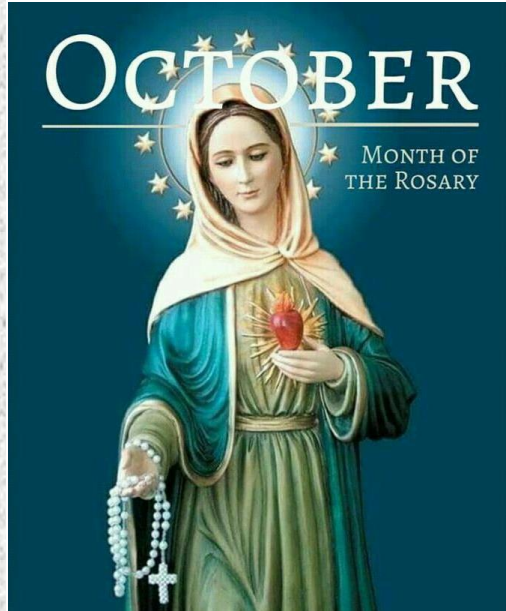
