FIRST EXAM: Lit C1 2 hours 80 marks 40%

Section A Shakespeare (40 mark) 1 hour

6.1 Extract (15 marks) 20 mins

Revise using the extracts in your Year 10 MoV Student Booklet.

The extract is 'unknown' and could come from any part of the play.

6.2 Essay (25 marks) 40 mins

You will be asked one about a character or theme.

You will **not** get an extract.

Section B. Poetry Anthology 1 hour

15 marks single poem 20 mins

25 marks compare poems 40 mins

The instructions will tell you the theme of the studied poem.

1 poem will be printed in the exam paper.

You must revise all poems.

SECOND EXAM Lit C2 2.5 hours 120 marks 60%

Section A.

An Inspector Calls (35 + 5 spag marks) 45 mins

You will have an **extract**.

You must relate to the whole play.

Revise characters and themes.

Use your class resources and AIC booklet to help you revise.

Section B.

A Christmas Carol (40 marks) 45 mins

Revise key themes:

Poverty, the poor

Charity

Christmas

Transformation

Ghosts

Turning points

1834 Poor Law

Malthus

You will have an **extract**.

You must relate to the whole novella.

You will be rewarded for relating context.

Use your class resources and your ACC booklet to help you revise.

Section C.

Unseen Poetry (40 marks) 1 hr

The instructions will tell you the theme of the poem. You will be told what the poem is about.

2 short poems will be printed in the exam paper.

3.1. You will be asked to write about one poem and how it presents a theme (15 marks)

3.2. You will be asked to compare the two poems. (25 marks)
