



# THE WORD

*"But whoever drinks the water I give them will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give them will become in them a spring of water welling up to eternal life." - John 4:14*

In this passage, Jesus meets a Samaritan woman at a well and offers her "living water." This means a life filled with God's love and purpose. The woman was surprised—she felt unworthy and was from a group that Jews avoided. But Jesus showed that God's love is for everyone, no matter who they are or what they've done.

This reminds us that Jesus satisfies our deepest needs. It's a message of hope: we all long for meaning and acceptance, and this story shows that we are valued and loved.

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






# THE WORD






# THE WORD

*Micah 6:8 - "What does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God."*

Blessed Rutilio Grande was a Jesuit priest in El Salvador who spoke out for the poor and against injustice. He believed that faith should lead to action—helping those who are suffering and standing up for what is right. His courage cost him his life, but his example reminds us that following God means caring for others, even when it's hard.

For Christians, this is a call to live out the Gospel in everyday life. For everyone, it's a challenge to stand for fairness and kindness in our communities.

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

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
