



Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live." - John 11:25


In Sunday's Gospel reading we learned about Lazarus, a friend of Jesus, dying. He weeps with Mary and Martha, showing His deep compassion, yet He also commands Lazarus to come out of the tomb, demonstrating His power over death. In the midst of grief and uncertainty, Jesus speaks words of hope: *"I am the resurrection and the life."*

For us, this means that death does not have the final word. Whatever feels lifeless in our lives—broken relationships, lost dreams, or spiritual dryness—Jesus can bring back to life. His presence turns despair into hope and mourning into joy.





THE WORD



"Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied." (Matthew 5:6)

Oscar Romero, Archbishop of San Salvador, lived in a time of great injustice and violence. Though initially seen as quiet and cautious, he became a courageous advocate for the poor and oppressed. His deep prayer life led him to speak boldly against injustice, even when it cost him his life. Romero reminds us that true discipleship means standing with those who suffer and being a voice for those who cannot speak for themselves.

His life challenges us: Where do we see injustice today? How can we respond with courage and faith? Like Romero, we are called to live the Gospel not only in words but in action, even when it is costly.







"Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord; let it be to me according to your word." (Luke 1:38)







THE WORD




"It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery." (Galatians 5:1)




